Dollars and sense

Through May, the club was operating at a \$5,000 loss with property taxes still outstanding. Major operational expenses are payroll, chemicals, property taxes and equipment maintenance. The board anticipated 2017 improvements 2017—along with an increase in scheduled tournaments and new members—would bring us closer to breakeven. A cooler than usual spring, low tournament revenue along with increased expenses have conspired to keep the club in the red.

While greens fees and tournament income supplement member dues, low member event participation have the board debating tournament strategy for 2019. Would the club be better off scheduling fewer tournaments—most on Sundays—leaving Saturdays open for green fees players? If so, which tournaments should be continued—the Member-Guest, Dome, Couples, Night Golf, Senior, Columbus Day? Share your thoughts with any board member.
