**Course play privileges**

To enjoy the rights and privileges of membership including tournament play, and avoid forfeiture, monthly installments need to be made in a timely manner.

As stipulated in the Club's bylaws, any member whose dues are delinquent 90 days will be notified, suspended and his/her name will be posted in the clubhouse.

In compliance with the bylaws, the board has authorized the treasurer to post names of members in the clubhouse.

If you are behind in your payments or have extenuating circumstances in bringing your dues up to date, please contact Tim Bryan.

**How is the Club doing?**

Every month the club's Profit and Loss Income statement is posted in the clubhouse. Three reports are available for June:

- June had a profit of \$768.
- Jan. 1—June 30, 2018. Loss of \$4,500 year to date.
- Comparison first half 2017 to first half 2018. Income in 2018 is down \$4,000, partially due to 2017's renovation and sign sales income. Delinquent 2018 dues also play a role, as well as increased expenses for payroll, maintenance and utilities.



A \$5,700 loan was secured in July to pay the Club's property taxes. A protest has been filed with the Montgomery County assessor to have the tax rate and current assets re-evaluated. Paying your dues on time is critical to meeting financial obligations.
