

Authorization approved

By a 26-to-5 vote at the July 19 board meeting, members authorized pursuing sales of the club's undeveloped acreage as 3-acre residential building lots for \$19,500 each.

Next steps include:

- Established a Residential Building Lots Sales & Homeowners Association Development Committee to research and present a concept to the board for HOA covenant and review building lot layouts. Michael Freisberg, Kerry Gorby, Tim Bryan and Frank LaForge are members, with an opening for another general member.
- Established a Strategic Planning Committee to work on a long-range financial spending plan. Initial members are Andy Allen and David Young, with openings for one board and two general members. An initial member survey indicated paying off debt is a top priority,
