Financial update

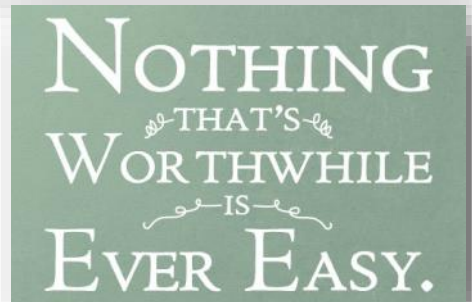
