One sign of residential lot sales progress is flags marking lot boundaries and drive right-of-way access. The survey is complete, clearing the way to create a purchase contract for six acres on the north fence line. After acquisition, a sales contract can be written to sell the first lot and an application submitted to the county zoning commission to enable additional sales.

The subdivision will be named **North Fore-Tee Place**. As soon as the plat is finalized and copies become available, a map will be posted in the clubhouse illustrating lot locations. Members will be notified by mail after county approval for first chance to purchase a lot before opening sales to the public.
