

Caney Golf Club (CGC) Cart Usage and Storage Policy

Effective 10-01-2020

Rules and regulations for use of private and rental golf carts at Caney Golf Club

- Drivers/renters must be 17 or older. Limit two persons per cart.
- Anyone who rents a CGC cart will be responsible for damages from negligent operation.
- Report rental cart damage or operational issues to the greenskeeper.
- Keep golf carts at least 30 feet from tee boxes and greens, and on paths where provided. Observe 90-degree rule from cart path unless otherwise posted.
- CGC management may restrict use of golf carts on the course at any time.
- CGC is not responsible or liable for losses incurred by private cart owners. You are solely responsible for providing your own liability and casualty insurance for your cart.
- As a condition of your cart storage and/or use at CGC, you agree to indemnify, defend and hold CGC harmless from and against any personal injury or property damage resulting to your cart or from the use of your cart.
- In the event of a private cart becoming inoperable while on the golf course, if CGC's personnel or equipment is used in assistance, CGC is not liable for any personal injury or damage to your cart that occurs as a result of said assistance.

Terms for personal golf cart shed space rental by members of Caney Golf Club

- Cart shed space rental is limited to those who are actively paying membership dues.
- Privately-owned carts loaned to a non-member are subject to these restrictions: Drivers must be 17 or older; a \$5 trail fee should be placed in an envelope and deposited in the green tube on the clubhouse front porch.
- Cart sheds are the property of CGC and those renting a space must be a good steward of the property. Renters are always expected to keep the doors closed and locked, other than during ingress and egress with carts. Do not leave cart sheds open as wind can inflict damage on people, nearby vehicles as well as hinges, doors, hasps, and framing of the shed space as well as the adjacent doors and connected structure.
- CGC is responsible for maintaining the sheds in operable order or providing a temporary space if repairs are underway, with exception of catastrophic weather events that eliminate available shed space.
- Damage to the shed, door, hinges, lock, hasp and framing due to leaving the doors open, colliding with structure or other forms of negligence are the responsibility of the renter. CGC will have damages repaired and pay for repair cost. CGC will mail an invoice to the renter to reimburse CGC for these expenses.
- Renters will not be held responsible for damage to cart shed from environmental events, structural failures or damage caused by other renters.
- Cart shed space must be maintained in the condition it was received, free from debris and excessive dirt.
- Cart shed spaces are non-transferrable. CGC reserves the right to terminate for cause any cart shed space rental.
- Only the golf cart on record may occupy the shed space.

Cart fees

- Rental cart: \$10 per rider for 9 or 18 holes. Does not include non-member green fee.
- Trail fee: \$15

Pay at Snack Bar, if staffed. Otherwise, place money in envelope and deposit in green pipe on porch wall.

- Electric cart shed space: \$190 a year pre-paid or \$16 monthly installment invoice.
- Gasoline cart shed space: \$165 a year pre-paid or \$13.75 monthly installment invoice.
