A brief history ...

Philsilat Sports Association is the National Sports Association (NSA) of pencak silat athletes and coaches in the Philippines. Philsilat is a recognized member of PERSILAT (the International Federation of Pencak Silat,) and APSIF (Asian Pencak Silat Federation), and a recognized NSA of the Philippines Sports Commission (PSC) and a regular member of the Philippine Olympic Committee or POC. Philsilat is founded in 2014 and is a registered entity with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) .

Philsilat is committed to bring Pencak Silat to a new height of sporting excellence and in the process we hope to nurture every Pesilat (Pencak Silat athlete) to realize his/her own maximum potential as an individual and as member of the society on a larger context.

Philsilat aims to promote, propagate and develop Pencak Silat as a sport that can be performed by all segments of the community in the Philippines, regardless of religion and culture. We aim to promote it as a healthy, popular and interesting activity. Furthermore, we hope to be the well known indigenous martial art sports in the Philippines that offers an avenue for community development through sports.

Since its initial existence from the first Pencak Silat national sports association up to the present NSA which is Philsilat, we have been bringing home, pride and recognition to our country, the Philippines. Philsilat in the past 6 years have, won Gold and Bronze Medals in the 2017, 2019 and 2021 SEA Games. In 2018 and 2019, Philsilat has been ranked as Top 4 and Top 7 respectively by our international Federation for its Outstanding performance in all the competitions we have participated in. In the 2018



Asian Games, our Team Philippines took home 4 Bronze Medals, the most number of medals gotten by a Team from the Philippines.

Our aim of helping the youth stay out of the street and teach them how to become a more responsible and productive member of our society starts with our program in the grass root levels. At present we have more than 3,000 youth athletes nationwide; and having provincial coordinators that work closely with their respective local government units and with the Department of Education for their active participation in the various sports program of the government. We always believe that our youth can be developed into a good citizens if we make them learn the discipline and ethics of any sports. We are a regular sports at Batang Pinoy (organized by the Philippine Sports Commission), SCUAA, and other regional athletic meet. Further, we are a demo sports at Palarong Pambansa (organized by the Dept. of Education).



... About the 2nd PERSILAT WORLD BEACH PENCAK SILAT CHAMPIONSHIPS

Beach Pencak Silat Championships was played for the first time during the 2016 Asian Beach Games in Danang, Vietnam.

The format for the **PERSILAT World Beach Pencak Silat Championships** is similar to the approved Pencak Silat event in the Asian Beach Games. The Match (Tanding) and Artistic (Seni) Categories will be in accordance to the Pencak Silat New Competition Rules & Regulations Version 5 (as of June 2022) and its corresponding amendments as of August 2022.

The 1st PERSILAT World Beach Pencak Silat Championships was held in Phuket , Thailand in 2019. The 1st World Beach Championships was able to pool together more than 15 countries all over the world to become part of this 5-day Pencak Silat competition with the beautiful beach of Phuket as its back draft.

This Year's edition of the PERSILAT World Beach Pencak Silat Championships will be held in the beautiful Island of Mactan, in Cebu Province, Philippines. Mactan Island boasts of fie white powdery beach sands perfect and ideal for a beach competition such as Pencak Silat.

Welcome to an Exciting destination CEBU!

Why Cebu?

Even before the Spanish colonization, Cebu already played a vital role in trade and commerce in Asia because the island has been gifted with a natural harbor. Its channel is deep enough to accommodate the flow of goods through international cargo sea vessels, and the Mactan island serves as protection from winds and current.



Cebu's weather promises to be good for business because typhoon activities are minor and rainfall is evenly distributed throughout the year. Moreover, the island is not located within any earthquake belt, there is no known active volcano, and its international airport has been large enough to connect the island to several continents.

The public administrators of the province have been known to be development-oriented, steering Cebu to greater heights by putting in place infrastructure facilities needed for economic growth.

Cebu has at least nine economic zones that offer to cut bureaucratic red tape by providing a much easier system for investors, plus incentives. It is number one because of good fiscal management: it ranks highest among the country's provinces in terms of assets and cash in bank.

Most importantly, Cebu ranks number one because of the current unity that has never been seen before in any province: unity among elected officials, unity among business groups, unity among its people, and unity between the private and public sectors.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Fully-vaccinated tourists from all countries, including their children, can now enter the Philippines without undergoing quarantine as long as they are fully vaccinated. Children below 12 years old are exempt from showing proof of vaccination as long as parents are fully vaccinated.
- Foreign nationals aged 18 and above who have received the primary series COVID-19 vaccine and at least 1 COVID-19 booster shot, fully vaccinated foreign nationals aged 12-17, and foreign nationals aged 12 and below regardless of vaccination status as long as accompanied by fully vaccinated parents are all exempt from presenting a negative RT-PCR or antigen test result.
- Partially vaccinated or vaccine-free tourists, on the other hand, are also allowed to enter but have to undergo a facility-based quarantine until the release of their negative RT-PCR test taken on the fifth (5th) day from date of arrival plus home quarantine until the 14th day from date of arrival and submit a negative RT-PCR test result taken within 48 hours or a negative rapid antigen test (administered by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility / lab / clinic / pharmacy)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be fully-vaccinated with acceptable proof of vaccination; minor children below twelve (12) years of age must travel with fully-vaccinated foreign parent/s. Acceptable proofs of vaccination include: World Health Organization International Certificate of Vaccination and Prophylaxis, VaxCertPH, National or state digital certificate of the country/foreign government which has accepted VaxCertPH under a reciprocal arrangement, and other proofs of vaccination permitted by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF).

Note: Fully vaccinated means the tourist received the second (2nd) dose in a 2-dose series or a single dose vaccine more than fourteen (14) days prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/port of embarkation. The vaccine must also be included in the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) List or Compassionate Special Permit (CSP) issued by the Philippine Food and Drug Administration; OR Emergency Use Listing of the World Health Organization



- Tourists not exempted from showing negative RT-PCR or antigen test results should take note of the following: the negative RT-PCR test result presented must be taken within forty-eight (48) hours; if antigen, the negative laboratory based antigen test result presented must be taken within twenty-four (24) hours prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to the Philippines, excluding lay-overs; provided that tourist has not left the airport premises or has not been admitted into another country during such lay-over.
- Passports valid for a period of at least six (6) months at the time of arrival to the Philippines.
- Valid tickets for return journey to the port of origin or next port of destination corresponding to their permitted / allowable duration of stay under a valid visa or visa-free entry; exemption to this requirement are foreign spouses and/or children of Filipino citizens and former Filipino citizens with balikbayan privilege under Republic Act No. 9174, including their foreign spouse and/or children who: (i) are not balikbayans in their own right and (ii) are traveling with them to the Philippines.
- One Health Pass QR Code: register at <https://www.onehealthpass.com.ph/> at least three (3) days prior to departure. Documents needed for registration include: proof of vaccination (children below 12 years old are exempted as long as accompanying guardian/parent comply with the set rules), confirmed booking from a Philippine Department of Tourism accredited establishment / hotel, return flight ticket to next destination / port of origin (not later than 30 days from date of arrival in the Philippines) and negative result of RT-PCR test taken within 48 hours prior to departure (children who are three (3) years old and below are exempted from the RT-PCR test requirement)

FAQ

- How do I access the One Health Pass?*

The website URL of One Health Pass is <https://www.onehealthpass.com.ph/>

- Do foreign travelers entering the Philippines still have to accomplish online the "One Health Pass"?

Yes, the One Health Pass must be secured because this is one of the requirements for entry to the Philippines.



- Can the One Health Pass be accomplished by hand on arrival in the Philippines?

The One Health Pass can be secured upon arrival to the Philippines, but it must still be accomplished online. We highly encourage securing the One Health Pass prior to departure from port of origin for a seamless and more convenient arrival to the Philippines.

- Do I have to pay to get the One Health Pass?

No. It is free of charge.

- As per IATF Redo 160-B, what are the "other proofs of vaccination permitted by the IATF" to prove vaccination status?

To date, there are no "other proofs of vaccination" yet aside from the following:

a. World Health Organization International Certificates of Vaccination and Prophylaxis;

b. VaxCertPH;

c. and the National/ state digital certificate of a foreign government that has accepted VaxCertPH under a reciprocal arrangement.

- If the vaccination certificate issued by a country is not recognized, is quarantine required? If yes, for how many days?

In the event that a tourist's vaccination certificate is not recognized by the Philippines, the visitor must undergo quarantine for five (5) days in a government-accredited quarantine facility. However, this is unlikely to happen as tourist's vaccination certificate will already be verified prior to their departure from port of origin.



HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Full board accommodation (Meals & Room) will be provided for each participating contingent which includes the registered athletes, coaches, officials, and appointed “International Technical Officials” (ITO).

Any contingents/individuals that is expected to be arriving or leaving OUTSIDE of the official competition date (Dec 4-15 of December 2022) would need make their own travel arrangements. The organizers will not be duty bound to assist them on their travel arrangements such as hotel bookings, transportation arrangements, etc.

The organizer will not bear the cost for any arrangement made before or after the official event date.

MEALS

During the competition, the organizer will also be providing **Halal meals** and it will be served in either buffet or packed food. The meals provided will be based on the sufficient supply of nutrition for each athlete’s consumption.

Rules & Regulations for the 2nd PERSILAT World Beach Pencak Silat Championship

The competition rules and regulations are complied with accordance set by the International Pencak Silat Federation (PERSILAT) and the International Pencak Silat Competition Rules and Regulations Version 5 as of June 2022 and its Amendments as of August 2022 .

1. Registration & Weighing-In

1.a) The Registration, Technical Meeting & Balloting process will be held on:

- **Registration of Contingent** - (upon Arrival starting from December 03 until December 05, 2022)

- **Technical Meeting & Balloting** - December 05 , 1:00pm

1.b) There will be “NO” weighing in during the registration. However, all participants MUST have their medical check-up done prior/before leaving their own country and also MUST produce/present/show the original copy of the “Medical Certificate” during the registration day.

1.c) All weigh-in is carried out in the morning of each competition day. No over weight tolerance will be allowed.

1.d) For any injury treatment in the hospital, the injured athlete is given until 1:00pm to weigh-in during the day of his competition.

1.e) The Competition Rules and Regulations are complied in accordance to the International Pencak Silat Competition Rules and Regulations Version 5 June 2022 set by the International Pencak Silat Federation (PERSILAT) and its Amendments as of August 2022.

1.f) When reporting for weigh-in, athlete must wear a standard Pencak Silat uniform without sash, groin guard or any other protective gears.

1.g) No tolerance will be given in favor of any athlete. Athlete will be given a choice to strip down completely before proceeding with the weigh in. Towels will be provided to assist the athletes. Separate rooms to be provided to conduct weighing-in.



1.h) The “Accreditation Pass” have to be worn during registration and weighing process.

2. Artistic Weapons

All weapon registration forms that will be sent later, must be filled and revert/ reply back to the Organizing Committee for the purpose of “Custom’s clearances” by the **November 15 2022**.

Single (Tunggal) Category

2.a) Long knife (Golok or Parang) measuring about 30 - 40cm and its made of metal and blunt (No sharp corners).

2.b) Toya/Long Stick/Tembung made out of natural rattan with the length between 150 - 180cm long and with a diameter of 2.5 - 3.5cm. These weapons **MUST** be inspected by the competition committee before the starting of the competition

Doubles (Ganda) Category

2.c) Besides the mentioned weapons of the same specifications as in the Single Category, competitors are allowed to use an additional (Optional) Nusantara weapon such as the “Keris”, “Pisau”, “Celurit” or a pair of “Trisula” as stated in the Pencak Silat Competition Rules & Regulations book. These weapons **MUST** also be inspected by the competition committee before the starting of the competition.

2.d) The Team Manager of the participating countries must submit the “Synopsis Form” for Doubles (Ganda) category before the starting of the competition.

Team (Regu) Category

2.e) Team (Regu) category is a category of Pencak Silat competition which it is performed by 3 (Three) athletes from the same team performing their skills (Repertoire) in a compulsory manner correctly, with accuracy, firmness, complete with the expressions, synchronization and compact with empty hands according to the rules and regulations applied for Regu category.

2.f) The **duration of time allocated for each performance is between 1 minute up to 3 minutes maximum.**

2.g) All participants must be in their own respective style of attire and performance in accordance to their own stance/identity/Perguruan).

2.h) All competitors must begin their performance with empty handed performance (No weapons) followed by the usage of weaponry for the succeeding sessions. There are no restrictions on the duration on time of these two sessions as long as it is completed within the allocated time of 3 (Three) minutes.

2.i) All competitors is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** from using the steps (Jurus) of Tunggal and/or Regu.

2.j) Each competitor is allowed to use 2 (Two) type of weapon listed in the Malay/Nusantara traditional weapons (Eg: “Keris”, “Pisau”, “Celurit”, “Trisula”, “Tombak”, “Kerambit”, “Sundang”, etc.) These choice of weapons must be inspected by the Organizing Committee before the competition starts. Use of Single Category Weapons shall not be allowed.

2.k) The organizer will **NOT BE PROVIDING** any choice of weapons for this category.

2.l)b The competitors will be judged by their criteria of Pencak Silat movements, the forms of the Pencak Silat and the discipline of the performances starting from the beginning till the ending of the performance.

3. Scoring

The organizer will be using the “Digital Scoring” and “Video Playback System” throughout the **2nd PERSILAT World Beach Pencak Silat Championship.**

4. Protests

The requisitions for the “Protest Form” must be made within 10 minutes after the official results of the competition has been announced; and the completed form must be returned within the next 20 minutes to the



Competition Secretary including the “Protest fee” of USD 300.00 in CASH. ***The protest fee is NON-REFUNDABLE to the Team Manager whether the protest appeal is accepted and approved by the Appeal Committee or not.***

5. Referees & Jury

5.a) The competitions will be conducted at all time by the certified Referee & Jurors appointed by PERSILAT. These individuals are qualified with the International Certification or individual country Referee Certificate sanctioned by their respective Pencak Silat Federations.

5.b) The organizer/host, **Philsilat Sports Association, Inc.**, will be fully responsible for their accommodations, meals & local transportations during the competition dates.

6. Medical & Insurance

6.a) A designated “Medical Team” will be on standby throughout the event.

6.b) If any participants required a further treatment in any hospital due to injury suffered during the competition, the organizer shall not be responsible for any of the cost incurred.

6.c) It is advised to acquire own/personal/team insurance coverage for this purpose.

6.d) Participants who requires a medical service must produce their own Identification card/Passport/Accreditation pass to the medical officials.

7. Protocol, Etiquette & Discipline

The protocol, etiquette & discipline for attire during **2nd PERSILAT World Beach Pencak Silat Championships** are as follows:

7.a) Opening Ceremony / Closing Ceremony

- ~ Official team tracksuit or Standard Pencak Silat attire

7.b) Prize Presentation

- ~ Official Team tracksuit



7.c) **During Competition**

Match – Standard Pencak Silat attire

Artistic – According to the International Pencak Silat Competition Rules and Regulations

7.d) **The discipline during ceremonies & competition are as follows:**

7.d.1) All participants must be on time and present in every ceremony & event according to the official schedule.

7.d.2) Participants must at all time, shows good personal appearance with a good attitude and the spirit of sportsmanship.

7.d.3) Participants should attend and adhere to any ceremony in an orderly manner and must not make any noise or disturbances which can disturb the solemnity of the ceremony.

7.d.4) A strict “Disciplinary Action” will be taken towards any athlete who will disobey or with a bad attitude.

7.d.5) No abusive and vulgarities language/words at all time.

7.d.6) No indecent hand gestures or signs at all time (Eg: Middle finger, etc.)

7.d.7) Strictly NO RACIAL or SEXUAL discriminations.

NOTE:

All accredited person involved in the Pencak Silat event is binded by the International Pencak Silat Competition Rules & Regulation (Version 5, June 2022) during games period as Stated in Article 2.2 . Any personnel who are found to breach the Code of Ethics, the Disciplinary Committee will act accordingly to the seriousness of the case.

Yellow & Red Card

All accredited persons (Technical Officials, Team Officials, Coaches and Athletes) are required to adhere to the code of ethic. Failing which, a penalty card will be issued to them as stated in article 18 of the International Pencak Silat Competition Rules & Regulation (Version 5, June 2022)



** IF ANY OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED ITEMS UNDER SECTION 7.D (Items 7.d.4 – 7.d.7), AND ESPECIALLY VIOLATIONS OF ARTICLES 2.2 AND 18 HAS BEEN COMMITTED OR NOT ADHERED TO OR FOLLOWED, THE ENTIRE CONTINGENT MAY SUFFER SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES SUCH AS , WILL BE BARRED AND SENT HOME IMMEDIATELY AT THEIR OWN COSTS AND ARRANGEMENTS.

8. Medals, Trophies & Mascot

8.a) Match Category

- 1st Place – Gold Medal, Mascot and Certificate for 1 person in each category.
- 2nd Place – Silver Medal, Mascot and Certificate for 1 person in each category.
- 3rd Place – Bronze Medal, Mascot and Certificate for 2 person in each category.

8.b) Artistic Category

- 1st Place – Gold Medal, Mascot and Certificate for 1 person in each category.
- 2nd Place – Silver Medal, Mascot and Certificate for 1 person in each category.
- 3rd Place – Bronze Medal, Mascot and Certificate for 2 person in each category.

8.c) The Best Athlete Award

“Best Male Athlete” – 1 Championship Trophy, an official mascot, a certificate & **Gift prize**

“Best Female Athlete” – 1 Championship Trophy, an official mascot, a certificate & **Gift prize**

The winners selected are based on these following criteria:

- Good sportsmanship & showmanship
- Numbers of matches (Rounds) the athlete has to fight



8.d) Trophies

There will be a total of 5 Championship Trophies to be won throughout the competition as per stated below. The trophies that will be won is based on the most “Gold medals” won and followed by “Silver & Bronze” medals, should there be a tie in the Gold Medal or Silver Medal recipients.

- a. **1 Trophy - OVERALL CHAMPION**
- b. **1 Trophy - 1st Runner-up**
- c. **1 Trophy - 2nd Runner-up**
- d. **1 Trophy - 3rd Runner-up**
- e. **1 Trophy - 4th Runner-up**

9. Drug Related Offenses

It is STRICTLY PROHIBITED to bring, carry, consume, hide or to distribute any kind of drugs or its equivalent substances in the Philippines at all time. Any participants caught or arrested by the Philippine National Police (PNP) or any authorized body and, found guilty of violating the Philippine narcotics law will be dealt accordingly with the proper Court of Laws of the Philippines.

The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any of this unlawful acts prosecuted by the Government of the Republic of the Philippines and its jurisdictions.

10. Doping

The Organizing Committee will be conducting a RANDOM doping check from time to time on ANY suspected winners in the finals of Artistic and Match categories carried out by the sanctioned Philippines National Anti-Doping Organization (PHI-NADO).
