

Floating high above the ground are the evil sky prisons that track down and trap any dragon they can find. Now there are only 3 free Dragons left: The Fire Dragon, Water Dragon and Thunder Dragon. Can you be the Dragon Hero and help free your dragon friends?

**Setup:**

Place any 3 Castles in a column



Place the Fire, Water and Thunder Dragons next to the castle of your choice.

Max 1 dragon per castle. Place on either side.



**Gameplay:**

Play a movement card. Each card has two move options.



Choose ONE of the options for each dragon to move that number of spaces

For this card EACH dragon can move 0 or 1 spots. You choose for each dragon!

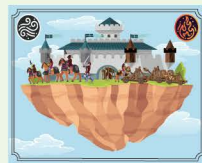
More than one dragon can land on the same spot!

After moving dragons, discard used movement card and do not use again.

**Moving:** Thunder Dragon moves 0 spots and stays in the same spot



Water Dragon moves 1 spot up



Move up, down or to the other side of the castle. You can not go above the top castle or below the bottom castle. If moving 2 spots you must move to a new spot.



Fire Dragon moves 1 spot to the other side of castle

## WINNING :

After the movement phase if you match the dragon and castle symbol on both sides you've freed the trapped dragon!



Flip over the castle card to release the dragon



Do not remove flipped castles. You still have to use movement spaces to land on or go past flipped cards.

Free all trapped dragons with the 9 movement cards and you win!

## INCREASED DIFFICULTY :

Add additional castles up to all 6 to increase the difficulty. With 4, 5 or 6 castles during setup not all castles will start with a dragon next to them. You choose the starting spot for all dragons.

Also each Dragon has a small symbol at the bottom corner. For another layer of difficulty the dragons can not land on the side of the castle that has that matching symbol.

## COOPERATIVE OPTION :

Play this game as a solo only game or as a cooperative game. As a cooperative divide control of the dragons by the number of players. With 3 players each player will pick and control a dragon throughout the game. With 2 players, one player will control one dragon and one player will control two dragons.
