Perseverance by Nazareth Rizkallah - PHM Board Member

Perseverance - This year's theme for NightVision 2022 is Perseverance.

Romans 8:25 "But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance."

What a great theme, following two years of a Pandemic that worked as a gauge for our faith and trust in God. Some failed and forgot God's faithfulness and promises, others persevered.

I learned a great lesson about perseverance in the most unlikely place.

It was around noontime at the maximum-security prison in Indiana. I performed for over 1000 inmates. After I finished the program in the yard, I was invited by some of the Christian brothers in the prison to visit their small chapel inside the prison. I followed them to the chapel, and there they conducted a full worship service. I went to the prison to bless them, but they ended up blessing me.

Following the service, I asked their chaplain to explain to me the writing on the wall. They had two walls full of writings. He explained to me that the right wall is where they write their prayer requests, and when God answers any of the prayers, with "Yes," "No," or "Wait," they write it on the left wall. As I started to look at both walls, I noticed that most of their prayers has been answered. That act made the inmates trust God more and also made them **persevere** knowing that God is faithful. He is the same yesterday, today and forever.

What a great idea. I started applying it in my life. In my journal I have pages with two columns. One for prayer requests, and the other for prayers answered. I write them down on the left column and when they are answered, I write it on the right.

Try it. It will help you remember God's faithfulness to you. His promises, and that will give you more **perseverance** as you wait for Him.

I pray that this year's NightVision will renew your faith and trust in God and help you persevere while you are waiting for Him to answer your prayers.

Deuteronomy 7: 9: Therefore know that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments.


NIGHTVISION IS BACK!

Crowder's first solo album, Neon Steeple, "Come As You Are".
American Prodigal, the follow-up album released in 2016, featured the song "All My Hope", which brought Crowder a No. 1 radio single. His third project, I Know A Ghost, hit #1 yet again on the Billboard Top Christian Albums Chart. His latest album, Milk & Honey, has the smash single "Good God Almighty," which hit #1 at Christian radio and #1 on Billboard's Hot Christian Songs chart, a first for Crowder. Milk & Honey, is a celebration of the hope that God's promise remains true.

As a Top-3 finalist on Season Eight of American Idol, Danny Gokey quickly became a favorite of millions. Danny has celebrated a series of #1s including Hope In Front of Me, Rise, and Haven't Seen It Yet, Spawning other singles like "The Comeback," "Love God Love People," and "Tell Your Heart to Beat Again," Danny has cemented his place on the radio charts with multi-week, multi-chart top-ten runs in the United States, Canada and now Latin markets with his Spanish singles. He has been honored with three Grammy nominations, three wins as KLOVE Male Vocalist of the Year, two Dove Awards and numerous Dove Award nominations.





Greg Laurie Greg Laurie is the senior pastor of Harvest Christian Fellowship with campuses in California and Hawaii. He began his pastoral ministry at the age of 19 by leading a Bible study of 30 people.

Since then, God has transformed that small group into a church of some 15,000 people. Today, Harvest is one of the largest churches in America, and consistently ranks among the most influential churches in the country.

In 1990, Laurie began holding large-scale public evangelistic events called Harvest Crusades. Since that time, more than 9.8 million people have participated in Harvest Crusades events in person or online around the United States. Greg has been married to Cathe Laurie for more than 40 years and they have two sons: Christopher and Jonathan. Greg and Cathe also have five grandchilden.

Mac Powell's Southern-drenched vocals have been a cornerstone of Third Day, one of contemporary Christian music's most successful groups, for the past three decades. So it's hardly surprising to most that Powell has found solo success as a bona fide country singer. His just-released sophomore country solo album, Southpaw, masterfully combines Powell's warm Georgia drawl with both high-octane Southern rock and beautifully rendered ballads.

Cory won three GMA Dove Awards, two K-Love Fan Awards, and the ASCAP Christian Song of the Year Award. In addition, he's received three Billboard Music nominations.

After taking a year-long sabbatical with his family, Cory is back on the scene with several new projects including a "Reckless Love" Remix, featuring Tori Kelly and Reckless Love the book, full of stories behind his hit song "Reckless Love."

Asbury's latest single, "The Father's House", reached Billboard Christian #1 status, becoming his second consecutive Billboard #1.

Featured Speaker David Nasser: In 1979, 9 year-old David and his family were forced to flee their home country of Iran amidst a bloody revolution, seeking asylum in America as refugees.

At age 18, after years of difficult assimilation to a new culture during a time when Iranian-American social and political tensions were high, David found hope and redemption through a relationship with Jesus Christ. For over 30 years, God has used and equipped David as a gifted evangelist, author, and campus pastor of the world's largest collegiate ministry. Recently, David and his wife Jennifer have moved to Franklin, TN to begin a new chapter as they lead a non-profit organization, the For Others Collective.

Comedian Nazareth originally from the Holy Land, has been honing his talents as a comedian for 25 years. Prior to moving to the United States to attend college at the University of Toledo Ohio, he uprooted from Kuwait with nothing other than a passion to make the most of the life he has been given. His passion for comedy ignited when he asked himself one day, "What do I want to do in life that if I never get paid for it, I'd still do it to the best of my ability?" Making people laugh was the only thing that came to mind. Nazareth has been MCing NightVision for several years now, blessing the Western Slope of Colorado.

After a runner-up finish on the reality show Rising Star, Austin French re-emerged in 2017 with an exuberant style of contemporary Christian pop tinged with soul. He reached the Top Ten of the Billboard Christian Songs chart with his debut single, "Freedom Hymn."

French grew up in Cordele, Georgia, and decided he wanted to be a contemporary Christian musician after attending a Christian music camp.

In 2017, he released his first single, "Freedom Hymn." His full-length debut, *Wide Open*, followed in September 2018. It included singles "Freedom Hymn" and "Born Again."

More than a collection of new songs, "Faithful God" is a look back and a look forward, a declaration of promises kept and promises yet to come.

Enter Social Club, the Miami duo whose built a cult following on the strength of their provocative oeuvre and singular, quick-witted approach. The self-monikered "Misfits" are disruptors in every sense, challenging norms and bringing other misfits along for the ride.





Born and raised in Southern California, The Young Escape is an electronic pop band from Southern California, composed of siblings Ryan, McKenna, Kyrsten, and Luke Johns.

The group delivers a fresh shot of indie pop with an energetic live show to match. The band's debut singles "Good Life" and "Love Me Like You" are an alchemy of modern pop sheen and sophisticated edge, carried to otherworldly heights by McKenna's vocal. Both singles secured #1 spots on the Hot AC Billboard chart.
