

BLACKOUT EVENT SERVICES PARTY BUS RENTAL AGREEMENT

1. RENTAL REQUIREMENTS

- Primary renter must be at least 21 years of age.
- A valid government-issued photo ID is required prior to service.
- Maximum passenger capacity is 22 passengers at all times.
- No underage drinking is permitted on the vehicle under any circumstances.
- Blackout Event Services reserves the right to refuse or terminate service for violations of this agreement or unsafe behavior.

2. PAYMENTS & DEPOSITS

- A non-refundable booking deposit of \$200 is required to reserve the event date.
- Full remaining balance must be paid no later than 14 days prior to the scheduled event date.
- A refundable \$500 security deposit is required for damages, excessive cleaning, smoking violations, bodily fluid cleanup, or other violations of this agreement.
- Security deposits are generally refunded within 24–72 hours following vehicle inspection.
- Renter authorizes Blackout Event Services to charge the card on file for unpaid damages, excessive cleaning fees, repair costs, overtime charges, or other violations incurred during the rental period.
- Any damages or fees exceeding the security deposit amount remain the financial responsibility of the renter.

3. PRICING

- 2 Hours — \$450
- 3 Hours — \$600
- 4 Hours — \$700
- Rates may vary for holidays, Husker game days, weddings, concerts, and special events.

4. RENTAL HOURS & OVERTIME

- Standard operating hours are between 10:00 PM and 2:00 AM unless otherwise approved.
- Overtime availability is not guaranteed.
- Rental time begins at the scheduled pickup time, not passenger arrival time.
- Late passenger arrivals do not extend the contracted rental period.

5. VEHICLE RULES

- No smoking or vaping
- No illegal drug use
- No weapons of any kind
- No standing through windows or sunroofs while the vehicle is in motion
- No excessive disorderly or unsafe behavior
- No damage to seats, lighting, flooring, sound system, or interior components
- Blackout Event Services reserves the right to terminate service immediately without refund if any prohibited activity occurs.

6. CLEANING & DAMAGE FEES

- Vomit or bodily fluid cleanup (minimum \$250 fee)
- Excessive trash, spills, or stains
- Burns, tears, or upholstery damage
- Broken equipment or damaged interior components
- Renter agrees to pay all repair, replacement, cleaning, downtime, towing, detailing, or restoration costs resulting from damages caused during the rental period.
- Blackout Event Services may use photographs, videos, invoices, receipts, or inspection reports as evidence of damages or excessive cleaning requirements.

7. CANCELLATION POLICY

- The \$200 booking deposit is non-refundable under all circumstances.
- Full payment is due no later than 14 days prior to the scheduled event date.
- Cancellations made more than 14 days before the event date will receive a refund of any payments made excluding the non-refundable \$200 booking deposit.
- Cancellations made within 14 days of the event date are eligible for a 50% refund of payments made, excluding the non-refundable \$200 booking deposit.
- Cancellations made within 7 days of the event date are completely non-refundable.
- Rescheduling may be permitted based on availability and management approval.
- Failure to appear at the scheduled pickup time may result in cancellation without refund.

8. LIABILITY

- Blackout Event Services is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
- Blackout Event Services is not responsible for passenger injuries caused by misconduct or failure to follow safety instructions.
- Blackout Event Services is not responsible for delays caused by weather, traffic, road closures, accidents, mechanical issues, or other unforeseen circumstances.
- Renter assumes responsibility for the conduct of all passengers during the rental period.

9. DRIVER AUTHORITY

- The driver has full authority to maintain safety and enforce all rules.
- Service may be terminated immediately without refund if passengers become violent, engage in illegal activity, create unsafe conditions, become excessively intoxicated, or violate any terms of this agreement.

10. GOVERNING LAW

- This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted under the laws of the State of Nebraska.
- Any disputes arising under this agreement shall be handled in the appropriate courts located within Nebraska.
