Updated Crew Officer Orientation Training

The National Venturing Committee and Scouting U are excited to announce the release of the updated Crew Officer Orientation training. This refreshed training resource is designed to help crew leadership better understand the roles and responsibilities of crew officers and learn how to effectively plan and lead meetings and events. It is strongly recommended that all crews complete this training annually, ensuring that every member has a clear understanding of officer responsibilities. Please note that completion of this training is required for advancement to the Discovery Rank. This updated training replaces the previous online version hosted on the Volunteer Learn Center.
