BeAScout Leads

As of the most recent report, there are more than 11,150 open leads (an increase of 17% over last week) and more than 2,000 pending applications (an increase of 54% over last week) awaiting follow-up in the online registration system. Each lead represents a family interested in learning more about Scouting, and each pending application is an excited new youth member who has already paid to join and is just waiting for unit approval. New Safeguarding Youth Facilitator Materials

We are pleased to announce that the Facilitator's Guide for In-Person Safeguarding Youth Training is now available for download in Vietnamese. The downloadable ZIP files include the Facilitator Guide (complete with tests and answer keys) as well as the accompanying videos. Please see your Scout executive for the links and share with training chairs, champions, district executives, and anyone else responsible for in-person facilitated training. The training is also available in English, Spanish, and Chinese. Important Note: This training is intended exclusively for use by training teams who are prepared to teach this course. It is not meant for broad distribution and should not be posted on publicly accessible websites. The new release of Safeguarding Youth Training supersedes all previous versions of in-person training materials, which should no longer be used.

National Jamboree Registration - Early Bird Deadline Approaching

The 2026 National Jamboree early bird registration fee of \$1,560 per participant ends *November 3rd*. After that, the price increases to \$1,800 per participant. See your council contingent coordinator for local details and read more about the Jamboree here.

Full Uniform Sale Promotion

Scouting America Outfitters has announced that starting *Tuesday, September 2*, families will have the chance to save on uniforms at National Scout Shops and participating local council shops. Families can now save 20% on a full Cub Scout, Scouts BSA, or Venturing uniform purchase between now and *October 31*. A full uniform purchase for Cub Scouts includes a top, bottom, belt, neckerchief, slide, cap, and socks. For Scouts BSA and Venturing, it includes a top, bottom, belt, cap, and socks. The previous offer of "10% off Uniform Bottoms when a matching uniform top is purchased" remains available as well through *December 31*.
