2025 Target Age Youth Data Now Available

The Target Age Youth data (TAY) for councils can be found by Scout executives on MyBSA. The folder contains two spreadsheets, one with the TAY by program and ethnicity and one with the TAY by gender and age. This data is provided by Experian and is based on the 2020 Census with yearly changes calculated by Experian algorithms for population growth and mobility. Nationwide TAY declined slightly from 2024 to 2025, and a slight downward trend was seen in most councils.
