Kodiak Challenge Has Been Discontinued

As BSA continues to streamline and refine its training, the Kodiak Challenge, a field-based leadership training that originated in the Venturing program, is being discontinued in favor of utilizing the primary leadership elements of the Venturing program. Currently scheduled Kodiak courses for individual crews (through summer 2024) may continue as planned. All other courses at other levels (multi-crew, district, council, etc.) should be cancelled. New courses at any level should not be scheduled or held. The National Venturing Committee is currently working on a survey to be sent out to Venturing youth to make sure that we are moving forward in a manner that will meet the program needs of Venturers. This survey will contain elements surrounding training and they hope to have the survey sent out within the first quarter of 2024. As the survey data is received, it will help determine the training needs within the Venturing program.
