National Camp Accreditation Program 2026 Standards

The 2026 standards document is now available [here](#). We highly recommend that all camp directors, program directors, rangers, short-term camp administrators, council National Camp Accreditation Program chairs, and staff advisers obtain a copy of the National Camp Accreditation Program Standards, either via free download or by purchasing a printed version through National Supply. Replacement pages are also on the website so you can easily convert your 2025 National Camp Accreditation Program Standards to the National Camp Accreditation Program Standards.

New Unified Scouts BSA Handbook

Based on significant feedback from youth and volunteers, Scouting America has announced the release of a unified *Scouts BSA Handbook* designed for all youth who are part of the Scouts BSA program. This handbook does not replace the current 14th Edition of the *Scouts BSA Handbook*, and this unified version has no major program changes. It is simply a single, unified version of the handbook that can be used by boys or girls in Scouts BSA. The text remains the same, but photos now reflect all youth in Scouts BSA. Leaders, youth, and units spoke about their desire for this unified version, and we listened. The handbook will be available for purchase at Scout Shops nationwide in January 2026.

2026 Special Needs Prepared Camp Pilot Program

Family Troop Option

The family troop model became available as a third option to all chartering organizations on **December 15, 2025**. The Scouts BSA Committee has prepared an "Intent to Convert" form for all troops intending to convert to the family troop model, along with a "Family Troop Registrar Guide" to assist your council registrar with processing family troops. Please share both documents with your appropriate council/district staff and volunteers. The "Intent to Convert" form should

also be shared with all interested troops. Once complete, troops should submit this form to their council registrar to assist in processing the change. This form is for local use only and should not be submitted to the National Service Center. As a reminder, you should also be sharing the “Family Troop Decision Guide” and “Family Troop Best Practices Guide” with your council/district staff and volunteers and all interested troops in your council. All troops who wish to discontinue the family troop model should be provided with the “Converting From a Family Troop Guide.” These materials have been distributed to local council Key 3s and territory leadership in an email from the Office of the President and CEO on *December 10*.
