

Stand-down Resumption Certification

On *Thursday, May 22, 2025*, a message was sent to local council Key 3s, territory leadership, territory Key 3+2s, the National Operations Leadership Council, High Adventure Base general managers, and the National Council CEO Management Team providing details on the Safety Stand Down that was implemented for all Range and Target Activities at Council and National High Adventure Base properties. The message also contained a Stand-down Resumption Certification. We have determined that each local council's Scout executive and each of the High Adventure Base general managers must complete, sign, and submit the certification in order for that council or base to resume Range and Target Activities. The safety stand-down will remain in place for any local council or base that does not submit the signed certification.
