#### **Distinguished Eagle Scout Award**

Each year the National Eagle Scout Association welcomes nominations for that year's class of Distinguished Eagle Scout Awards. Established in 1969, the Distinguished Eagle Scout Award is the highest honor they bestow upon Eagle Scouts. The nomination window opened *April 1* and closes precisely at midnight on *July 31*. However, many people are unsure of who qualifies for this prestigious honor or may feel intimidated by the nomination process. To help, the National Eagle Scout Association put together a brief guide for those looking to nominate a deserving Eagle Scout here.

#### **National Exploring Live Hour**

The National Exploring Live Hour is a monthly Zoom video conference that will help engage and equip Exploring volunteers and professionals to grow, support, and learn more about Exploring. Each month the National Exploring Live Hour will be led by the National Exploring program chair and the National director of Exploring. The live hours will include sharing best practices and ideas that are happening within councils, highlighting successful growth campaigns, and inspiring new ideas through various trainings. This will also offer an opportunity for local councils to collaborate with territory and national counterparts to generate innovative solutions to real-life Exploring challenges. #### Scouting U at Philmont

Scouting U has four conferences planned at the Philmont Training Center the week of *July 13-19*: "Innovate and Facilitate" (which consists of two, two-day conferences – "Acquire the Facilitators Advantage" and "Strategic Training Plan"); "Nuts and Bolts of Training"; "Wood Badge Co-Hort", and "National Youth Leadership Training Power-Up: Purpose in Service". There will be two professional development classes offered as well. Scouting U will be joined by the Council Key 3 Conference and the Scouting America Employee Retirees Reunion. ### Jamboree Payments –Upcoming Due Date

Jamboree payments will be billed through the standard PeopleSoft billing process, consistent with other National invoices. The process remains the same as in prior Jamborees. As a reminder, the first Jamboree payment is due in May, and councils will be billed for the units they have registered in the Jamboree registration system. Councils should plan accordingly to ensure timely payment.

#### Coming Soon - The 2025 Performance Uniform Shirt

Following last week's launch of the 2025 Performance Uniform Short, the next evolution in our uniform lineup - the 2025 Performance Uniform Shirt - has been announced. The men's and women's shirts will begin arriving at the National Distribution Center this week and will be available for ordering by local council locations starting *Wednesday*, *May 9*.

#### New Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification

Employers must complete a Form I-9 to verify an employee's identity and employment authorization. The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Citizenship and Immigration Services has released an updated version of Form I-9, and Employment Eligibility Verification and Instructions for Form I-9 each having an expiration date of *May 31, 2027*.
