Scouting America is pleased to introduce the Family Troop option for councils participating in the 2026 National Jamboree. Beginning *December 15, 2025*, councils may form new Family Troops or convert existing boy or girl Jamboree troops, provided there is broad support from registered families, adult volunteers, and Scouts. Councils may add new Family Troops as half units (20) or full units (40) but may not reduce the number of units they committed as of *November 3, 2023*. See more <a href="here">here</a>.
