Preamble:

Shri.B.Shamsunder Memorial College of Physical Education, Gulbarga, Karnataka has been granted recognition by SRC for offering B.P.Ed course with an intake of 40 (forty) students. Recognition order has been issued on 14.10.1996 for the session 1996-1997. Subsequently on review of the Performance Appraisal Report for the session 2003-2004 the intake of the institution has been fixed as 40 (forty) for the session 2004-2005.

Now, the institution has submitted a request dt.10.19.2009 for re-fixation of intake from 40 to 50. The institution has stated that it is running the institution since 1982 with the permission of the Government of Karnataka and affiliated to Gulbarga University till date. The institution has stated that renewal of recognition has been sought from NCTE for the session 2004-2005.

The institution has stated that the Gulbarga University in its letter dated 02.02.2007 has enhanced the intake from 40 to 50 as one unit for the academic session 2006-2007, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 and has asked to produce the renewal of recognition obtained from the NCTE to accord the affiliation for the year 2009-2010.

Hence, the institution has requested to issue the renewal of recognition as well as to re-fix the unit as 50 students as fixed by the University.

SRC in its 187<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 29-30 December 2009 considered the request of the institution and decided that the strength be enhanced from 40 (forty) to one basic unit of 50 (fifty) as per NCTE norms.

Hence the order.


**ORDER**

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Karnataka People's Education Society, Near Siddharth Vihar, Kushnoor Village, Gulbarga – 585106, Karnataka has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Shri.B.Shamsunder Memorial College of Physical Education, Near Siddharth Vihar, Kushnoor Village, Gulbarga – 585106, Karnataka for conducting B.P.Ed course for re-fixing the intake of 50 students on 14.10.2009 in place of 40 students.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Shri.B.Shamsunder Memorial College of Physical Education, Near Siddharth Vihar, Kushnoor Village, Gulbarga – 585106, Karnataka** for conducting B.P.Ed course of One year duration by re-fixing the annual intake of **50 (Fifty)** students which includes the existing intake of **40 (Forty)** students and an additional intake of **10 (Ten)** students from the academic session **2009-10** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007 subject of fulfillment of the following conditions:
3. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
  - I. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE( Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations,2007.
  - II. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UCC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
  - (i) Copy of the Application Form
  - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
  - (iii) Staff Profile
  - (iv) Recognition letter
  - (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
