# Summer Program

At One Step A La Vez, our mission is to create safe spaces for teens to grow, lead, and build a better future for themselves and their community.

Mission & Purpose of

Our One Step Summer Program is an extension of that mission. By offering teens opportunities to explore new environments, build meaningful relationships, gain college and career exposure, and receieve positive mentorship all summer long.

Through weekly trips, hands-on activities, guest speakers, and cultural excursions, we aim to:

- Reduce summer isolation and promote youth wellness.
- Build leadership, confidence, and independence.
- Introduce teens to higher education, career paths, and local resources.
- Encourage commitment, responsibility, and community connection.
- Provide safe and supervised fun that affirms every teen's identity and values.

This program is built for youth in Fillmore, Piru, and Santa Paula who want to stay active, inspired, and involved because every teen deserves a summer filled with growth, joy, and belonging.



## **Rules and Guidelines**

#### **Attendance Commitment**

Space for our summer field trips is limited. Each trip has a set number of transportation spots and staff support. Because of this:

- Teens who sign up for a trip but do <u>not</u> attend without notice will not be allowed to sign up for the next trip.
- Teens must provide no later than 48-hour notice if they can't attend.

This policy helps us ensure that available spots go to teens who are ready to participate and avoids lastminute cancellations that may result in wasted resources.

#### **Transportation Guidelines**

Teens must:

- Arrive on time at the center for trip departures.
- Check in with a staff member before boarding.
- Stay for the duration of the trip (no early pickups at the event site unless pre-arranged with staff).

#### **Expectations & Policies**

All teens are expected to follow our community values of respect, responsibility, and inclusion. While attending summer program activities, teens must:

- Follow staff instructions at all times.
- Be respectful to peers, staff, and community members.
- Stay with the group during off-site activities.
- Use kind and inclusive language.
- Avoid any aggressive, unsafe, or disruptive behavior.

If a participant does not follow these expectations, they may be:

- 1. Warnings: The Youth will receive up to 3 behavior warnings.
- 2. After 3 Warnings: The teen will not be allowed to attend the next trip or activity they signed up for, and a parent/guardian will be contacted for a check-in.
- 3. If a behavior issue happens again after the first phone call, the youth will be removed from the summer program, and a second call will be made to inform the parent/guardian.

This policy ensures fairness and safety for everyone in the program. Our goal is to help youth grow and succeed while respecting the experiences of others.
