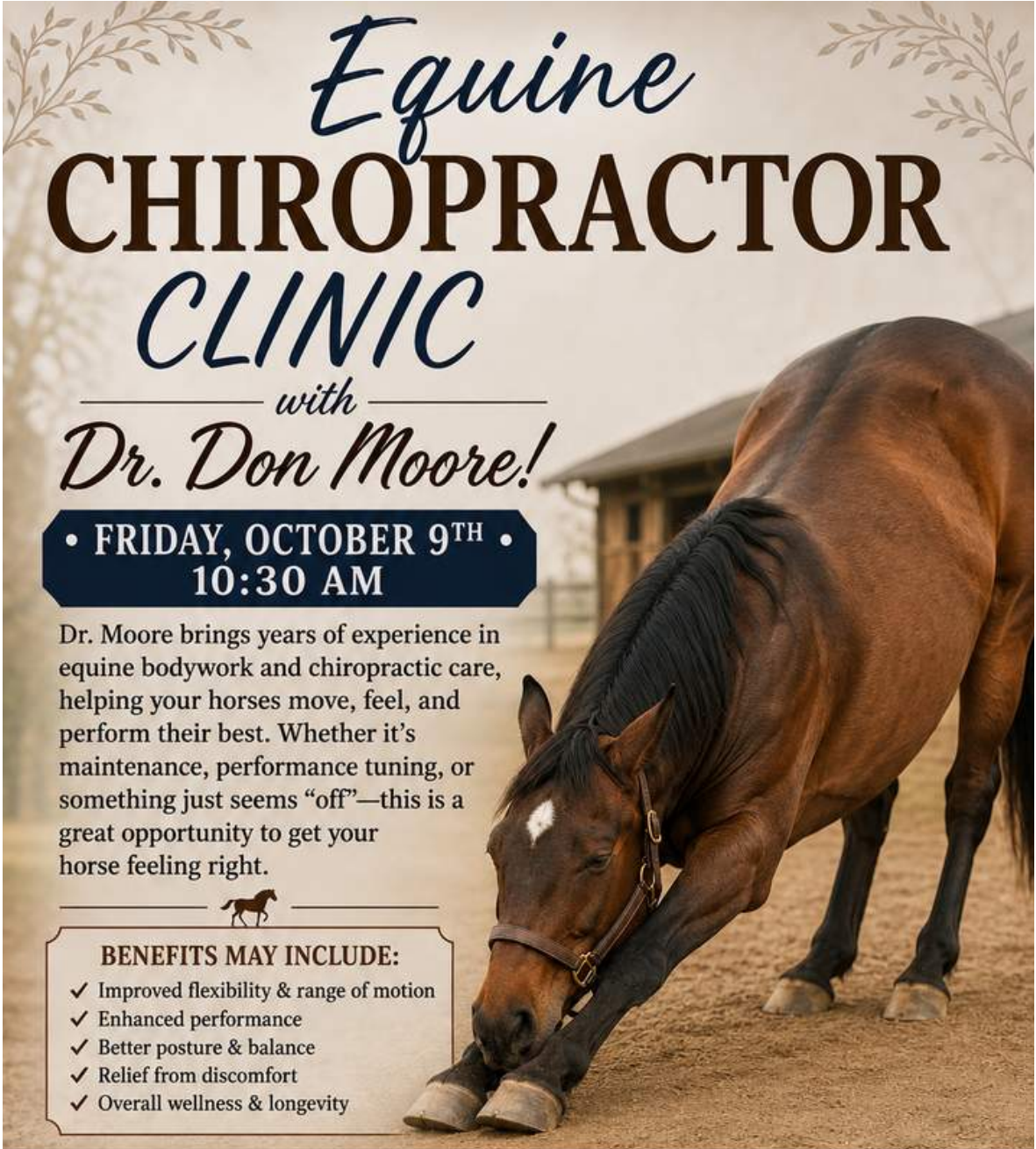

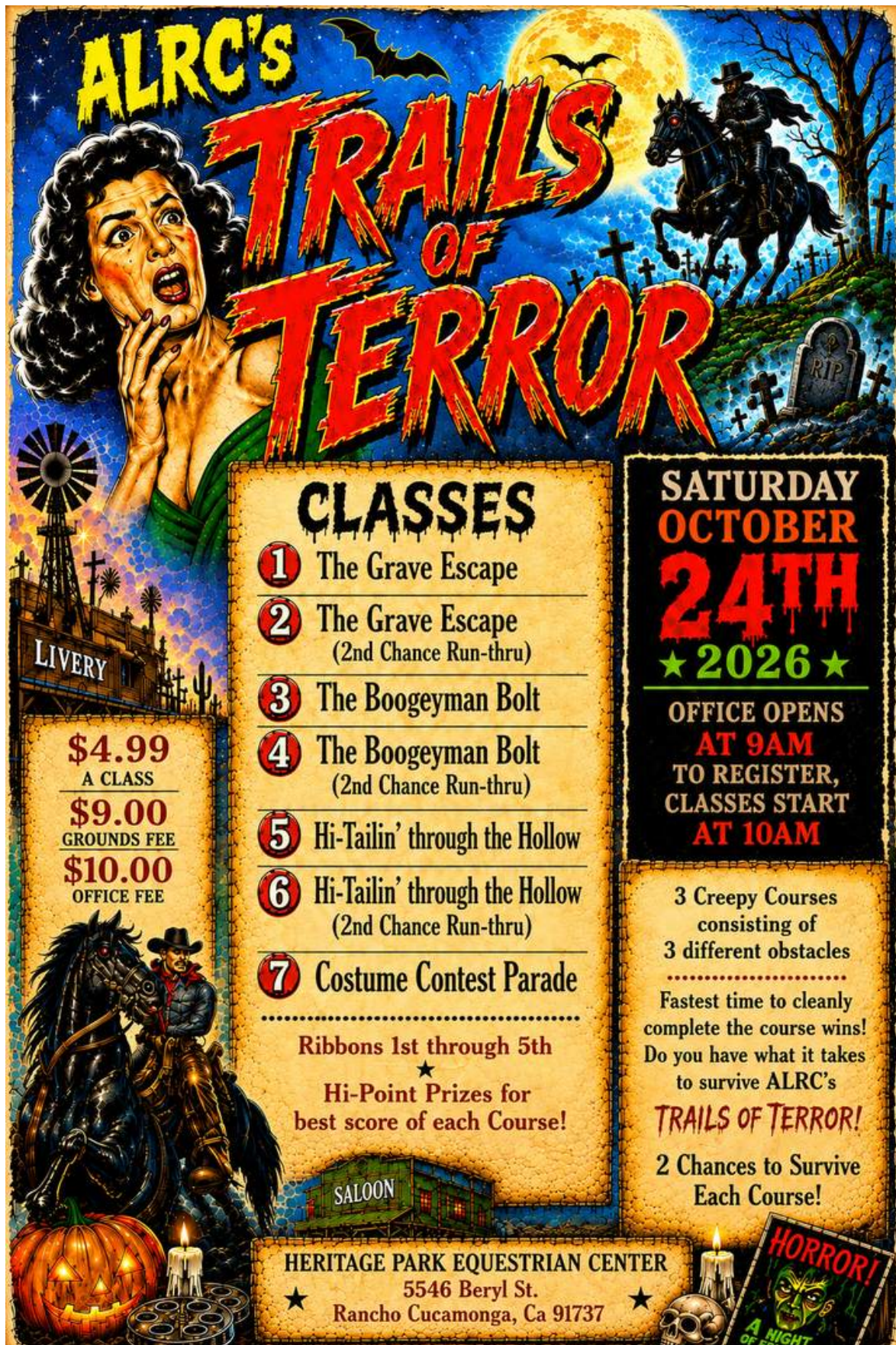

You may have noticed how nicely groomed the arenas and round pens are looking. It's thanks to the newest recruit to ALRC's maintenance crew. Jim Hansen, ALRC member, volunteered to start harrowing the arenas and round pens about six weeks ago. He calls it his "Zen Garden Meditation Time." With a 30+ year career specializing in maintenance, planning and construction in higher education, including Pomona College in Claremont, Jim is well-versed in maintaining grounds and operating grounds equipment.

His plan is to groom the arenas and round pens every Friday starting at 7am so that the facility will be ready for weekend use.

The process takes about 3-4 hours, so you'll see Jim out on the tractor early Friday mornings. What makes it especially convenient for Jim is that he lives right across the street from Heritage Park. Like many things in life, it takes two to do the job, the operator, and the supervisor who is required to be on site while the tractor is in use. Kathy Hansen, Jim's wife, has volunteered for the role and says she has a lot of experience supervising Jim. Both have been trained in their respective jobs and completed all paperwork for the city and their volunteer roles.
