ALRC will be abiding by all current health and safety precautions to ensure safety of our participants and spectators. All participants and spectators are asked to maintain a 6-foot distance and practice current safety measures to ensure we all stay safe at our show.



Open Horse Show Rules Alta Loma Riding Club

- 1) Boots are required for all riders.
- 2) Show-appropriate attire is required when showing for placing or points. Chaps are optional.
- 3) The age of rider is determined as of 1/1/21 and remains the same throughout the show year.
- 4) A rider or handler must be at least 18 to show a stallion.
- 5) All riders in Lead line class are required to wear helmets
- 6) Open classes are open to all participants
- 7) Entry fees must be paid at show office prior to receiving entry numbers. Cash and checks only are accepted, **credit** cards are not accepted. There will be a \$50 service fee for each returned check.
- 8) **Open checks or extra cash** must be provided with entry to be able to add or scratch classes at the gate, otherwise you must pay for any added class at least 2 classes prior in order to get in the class. **No refunds for missed classes.**
- 9) All entries must pay a grounds fee for each horse. Grounds fee can not be waived.
- 10) Snack bar accepts cash only, please plan accordingly
- 11) All walk/trot classes are listed as such. If the class does not say walk/trot (W/T), then it is a cantering or loping class (except any "In Hand" class such as halter, showmanship and lead-line). Riders may NOT cross enter leadline; walk/trot; cantering/loping divisions on the same horse. Playday "Fun" classes open to all participants
- 12) The terms Trot or Jog are used for intermediate gaits for English or Western respectively. Gaited horses will use their intermediate gait when trot or jog is called for.
- 13) Show management will determine the working order when necessary.
- 14) Alta Loma Riding Club reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, also to disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel awards without claim for damage.
- 15) Alta Loma Riding Club reserves the right to cancel or combine classes due to lack of participation (less than 3 entries in a class).
- 16) The Judge's decision is final for all classes, there is no protest process.
- 17) Riders or horses that are out of control or considered a safety risk will be excused from a class or the entire show.
- 18) Unsportsmanlike exhibitors will not be tolerated anywhere on the premises. Any disruptive or dangerous behavior from either exhibitors or horses, including abusive or foul language, is grounds for being excused or removed from the show and no fees will be refunded. We strive to promote a pleasant show experience for all attendees.
- 19) One minute second gate calls will be enforced. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be at the entry gate when their class is called. If an entrant misses a class without cancelling, no refund is given, so please plan ahead.
- 20) Tack changes must be requested at least 2 classes prior, and only 5 minutes will be allowed for a tack change. Please plan ahead, you may not have time to go back to your trailer to change.
- 21) Timing of breaks will be determined during the show and announced. There are no guaranteed breaks.
- 22) Refunds of class fees may be provided under certain circumstances. Grounds fees will not be refunded.
- 23) All dogs must be on a leash and under the control of a person. For the safety of everyone at the show, exhibitors and spectators may be asked to leave if their dog is found loose on the grounds.
- 24) ALL BREEDS OF HORSES ARE WELCOME TO PARTICIPATE IN CLASSES AND BE JUDGED TO THEIR BREED
