ACWR EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FROM M. JANET WILSON MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT FUND

Sister Wilson was an advocate for higher learning which started back to her life in Brooklyn, New York with the rearing of eight children. When she moved from New York to Pennsylvania her thirst continued, and it was there that she was introduced to the New Testament Church of Christ by the late Brother Roldo Cook.

Her newfound faith had her searching for other African Americans within the Christian Church/Church of Christ congregations. She was then directed to the work in Pittsburgh, PA at the Brushton Church of Christ where she meets Susie Jenkins (Doswell) who would later help start and lead the ACWR organization. Even then the desire continued for her to better equip herself to reach and teach others.

After much prayer she was encouraged by her husband, the late William Daniel Wilson Sr along with other family members and friends to enroll at the College of the Scriptures (COS) in Louisville, KY. God allowed her to earn her GED (General Education Diploma), Bachelors' Degree and then her Masters'.

In her years at COS, she travelled extensively raising funds and bringing awareness about the school by doing speaking engagements, VBS, and or women's retreats. To her dismay she discovered that African American women were not given the same opportunities to teach and speak. Out of this observation the idea of the Annual Christian Women's Retreat was born in 1979 which would give African American Christian women an opportunity to come together for fellowship, spiritual strengthening, and empowerment and to have a forum for training and education.

Sister Wilson worked diligently with the retreat alongside other women until she answered the call to foreign missions' full time. She did this from 1986 until her death in 2001. Her greatest joy came when she was teaching others of God's Word and His saving grace!

The Legacy Continues

The first ACWR retreat was held in 1980 and has continued faithfully every year since its inception. Four years after the retreat was founded, an organizational structure was put into place to operate the retreat organization in an orderly fashion. Bylaws were established, officers elected, and positions were added as the retreat experienced growth. For the retreat to benefit women in many geographic locations, the retreat is held in various locations each year.

The first Mattie Janet Scholarship was given in 2008, and a total of eight scholarships have been given to date.
