

~~ Hopevale Memorial Cathedral in the Glen: This replica of a chapel built by 11 American Baptist missionaries in the Philippines during WWII is a peaceful spot in the woods. Peace even in war!

~~**Spurgeon Chapel:** Visit this historic chapel, built in 1904, a place for quiet meditation and prayer. God is able!
