Rogers Range Gear Checklist

- ☐ Directions to Mission Critical
- ☐ Entry gate code to the Mission Critical Ranch
- ☐ Hotel - booked and confirmed (our clients prefer to stay in Gatesville)
- ☐ Pistol
 - ☐ 4) high capacity mags
 - ☐ Mechanical mag loader (optional)
- ☐ Pistol - second pistol (optional, but a very good idea if you have one)
- ☐ Holster - outside the waistband preferable (the pistol is going to get HOT)
- ☐ Belt (mandatory) - sturdy everyday carry gun belt, duty belt rig or battle belt
- ☐ Magazine holsters / carriers (mandatory) - at least two
- ☐ Dump pouch for your belt (you will be reloading magazines non-stop)
- ☐ Ammo - if range pre-approved and not purchasing from Mission Critical
- ☐ Shooting glasses - ballistic rated (mandatory - must be worn at all times)
 - ☐ Tinted for daytime
 - ☐ Clear for overcast and night shooting
 - ☐ Prescription glasses or contacts
- ☐ Electronic hearing protection (mandatory)
 - ☐ Batteries - extras for hearing pro
- ☐ Liquid hand chalk is recommended (Petzl Power Liquid, Pro Grip, etc)
- ☐ Flashlight - hand-held type for night shoot (if this is part of your package)
 - ☐ Batteries - extras for flashlight
- ☐ Seasonally appropriate clothing (check the weather prior to class)
 - ☐ Long pants with belt loops (shorts are not allowed at any time)
 - ☐ Shirts - no low cut tops - hot brass down the shirt is a no-go
 - ☐ Baseball cap (to keep hot brass from getting behind your glasses)
 - ☐ Closed toe shoes are required (no flip-flops or sandals)
- ☐ Cleaning & lube kit
- ☐ Parts and tool kit - spare pistol parts if you have them
- ☐ Iron sight fiber optic replacement filament (if using fiber optic sights)
- ☐ Red dot site batteries (if using a RDS)
- ☐ Ensure iron sights / RDS are thread locked and zeroed prior to class
- ☐ Food & Drinks (the nearest store is about 30 minutes away)
 - ☐ Lunches
 - ☐ Snacks
 - ☐ Drinks
 - ☐ Electrolytes
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Medication(s)
- ☐ Band-Aids and athletic tape (to tape up the hot spots on your fingers)
- ☐ Note taking gear
