Modified FBI Shooting Qualification State of Texas / LEOSA Aim True Group, LLC

This is a 50 round qualification (shooting test) performed <u>from concealment</u>. All shooting is performed static, facing the target, from the standing position, on a B-27 target.

The test will be administered a maximum of twice per day, back to back. Shooters failing to pass after the second attempt will be required to schedule a new qualification date and pay the qualification administration fee again.

Failed par times result in immediate disqualification / stopping of the test. The test will then need be re-shot starting from the beginning.

Safety violations of any kind will result in immediate disqualification and removal from the range. No refunds will be made and no potential for future re-scheduling of the test will be offered. Any accidental / negligent discharges require an Accidental Discharge Incident Report on Form ETR-98 to be filed with the Texas Department of Public Safety (TXDPS) Regulatory Services Division (RSD).

Shooter induced errors (magazines not loaded correctly, no round in the chamber, etc) will result in a loss of all points for the string. The string will not be re-shot.

Ammunition failures (failure to fire) and weapon malfunctions (failure to feed / failure to extract) will result in a re-shoot, <u>only</u> if immediate remedial action was performed and the string of fire was completed. Failure to perform remedial action will result in a loss of all points for the string.

SCORING

Hits:

There are multiple rings on the B-27 target (as depicted) for scoring. Everything in the 8 ring and in is 5 points.

Inside the 7 ring is 4 points.

Outside the 7 ring but still in the body is 3 points.

Par Time:

All shots fired for each stage must be completed at or under par. Par time begins upon the initiation of the draw.

Passing Score for TX LEOSA:

175 points out of a possible 250 points / 70%.

Course of fire #1: 3 Yard Line (12 rounds total)

- 1. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 5 seconds (par time) using your strong hand only
- 2. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 5 seconds using your strong hand only
- 3. Draw and fire 3 rounds using your strong hand only, switch hands, fire 3 rounds using your weak hand only. All 6 rounds must be fired in under 10 seconds.

Course of fire #2: 5-Yard Line (12 rounds total)

- 1. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 4 seconds using two hands
- 2. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 4 seconds using two hands
- 3. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 4 seconds using two hands
- 4. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 4 seconds using two hands

Course of fire #3: 7-Yard Line (16 rounds total)

- 1. Draw and fire 4 rounds in 5 seconds using two hands
- 2. Draw and fire 4 rounds in 5 seconds using two hands
- 3. Draw and fire 4 rounds, reload, fire 4 rounds using two hands. All 8 rounds must be fired in under 13 seconds.

Course of fire #4: 15-Yard Line (10 rounds total)

- 1. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 6 seconds
- 2. Draw and fire 3 rounds in 6 seconds
- 3. Draw and fire 4 rounds in 8 seconds
