



Shooting Positions

Diamonds & Derringers



EXTENDED READY (AKA Low Ready)

Extended Ready position begins with the body centered on the target and the pistol pointed where the base of the Target meets the ground (conceptually at the target's feet).

Eyes are focused on the intended point of impact. The trigger finger is indexed along the side of the frame and outside of the trigger guard.



TRANSITION

Transition position is the midpoint between drawing and presenting the pistol. Transition begins with the body centered on the target, and the pistol oriented toward the center of the target. Eyes are focused on the intended point of impact. The trigger finger is indexed alongside the frame and outside of the trigger guard.



HOLSTER

Drawing from the holster typically begins with hands relaxed naturally at sides, wrists below the belt line. Both outside the waistband (OWB) and inside the waistband (IWB) holsters are acceptable.
