PD

This PD is not timed or scored. The pneumatic head plates are operated manually by the Instructor.

This is a pass or fail basic proficiency demonstration.

Each of the below PD's will first be demonstrated by an Instructor, then repeated by the shooter.

Magazine load-outs prior to performing the PD's

Mag 1 = 6 rounds Mag 2 = 10 rounds In Your Pocket/On the Table = 4 rounds

- PD1 Load and Make Ready:** First: Beginning with a holstered empty pistol, draw the pistol from the holster to the transition position, then load and make ready utilizing Mag 1 (the 6 round magazine). Second: Shooter demonstrates a press check, recovers to transition position, then holsters the pistol.
- PD2 Top-Off 1:** Remove Mag 1 from your pistol **without unholstering**. Re-insert and fully seat Mag 1 again while the pistol remains holstered.
- PD3 Top-Off 2:** Draw your pistol from the holster, perform a tactical reload utilizing Mag 2 (the 10 round magazine), then re-holster. Stow the extra magazine (Mag 1). Perform the same drill again, ensuring the original Mag 1 (the 6 round magazine) is back in the pistol. Stow Mag 2 and holster.
- PD4 Up Drill - Holster:** Shooter assumes a relaxed position, with hands at sides below the belt line. When the T1 head plate is manually driven up, shooter draws and fires the pistol with two hands, knocks down T1, recovers to transition position with two hands, then holsters. Stage runs for 5 cycles, with a pause between each to recover back to the holster.
- PD5 One Reload One - Holster:** Shooter assumes a relaxed position, with hands at sides below the belt line. When the T1 & T3 head plates are manually driven up, shooter draws and fires the pistol with two hands, knocks down T1, reloads behind cover with two hands, then knocks down T3. **Standby until all shooters have holstered prior to collecting your empty magazine and setting it up again.** Stage runs for 5 cycles, with a pause between each to recover back to the holster.
- PD6 Malfunctions - Transition:** Shooter sets up the malfunction, then assumes the transition position. When T1 head plate is manually driven up, the shooter will present the pistol and attempt to fire, clear the malfunction, then engage the T-1 head plate with **one** round. Upon completion, the shooter will setup the next malfunction in preparation for the following string. The stage consists of three strings total.
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|---------|------------------------------------------|------------------------------|------------------------|
| 1 round | Malfunction 1: Failure to Fire | (Chambering or Primer Issue) | Immediate Action Drill |
| 1 round | Malfunction 2: Failure to Eject | (Stove Pipe) | Immediate Action Drill |
| 1 round | Malfunction 3: Failure to Extract | (Double Feed) | Remedial Action Drill |
- PD7 Unload, Show Clear...** Shooter is to unload, show clear, hammer down and holster. Cadre observes basic pistol handling skills.
- PD8 Down Range Procedure:** Cadre will call out: "Your line is safe and holstered, turn your lights on, go down range, paint 'em up". Cadre members will move down range with shooters providing instruction regarding safety and target painting methodology.
