WHO'S WHO AT THE GIG

1 Te Kaiwhakahaumaru

Ko tōna kawenga matua, ko te manaaki i te kuaha o mua, te taha o te atamira anō hoki.

Security

Used for safety on the door as well as near the stage.



2 Te Kaihokohoko Rawa

Ka hoko atu i ngā tikiti, ka tiaki i te tahuā pūtea, ka whakamana i ngā tikiti o ngā manu moata, ka hoko atu i ngā rawa, ka mutu, ka tiaki i te rārangi ingoa o ngā manuhiri tuārangī. He wārin nui tō te tangata nei, rokohanga atu tētahi tangata pai, tangata kōunga ake nei.

Door Person/Merchandise Seller

Sells door tickets and accounts for money, processes pre-sold tickets, sells merchandise and looks after the guest list. Worth their weight in gold – get a good one.



3 Te Kaipūkaha Whakahenumi Oro

Ka whakahenumi i te te oro ka puta ki te marea ki roto i te whare karioi. Kāore e kore ka whāia ngā whare karioi motuhake i o rātou ake 'Kaipūkaha Whakahenumi Oro' – A kāti, koia tētahi tangata ki whakahenumi i ngā oro o te whakaaturanga, o te kaupapa ngahau rānei mō tētahi utu ka utua e te kaitiaki o te kaupapa.

FOH Engineer

Mixes the sound in the venue that the audience hear. Dedicated music venues will likely have a 'house engineer' – someone who mixes all performances in the venue for a fee that is payable by the hirer.



4 Te Kairarama

Ko te kawenga o Te Kairarama ko te whakahaere i ngā rāiti me ngā taunakitanga ki runga i te atamira pērā i te mihi hukahuka maroke.

Lighting

Controls the lights and any other on-stage effects such as dry ice machines.



5 Te Kaiwhakahaere o te waahi

Koinei te tangata ka whakamana i ngā tāpuitanga. Ka manaaki tēnei tangata i te wātaka o te whare karioi, ka mahi tahi ki ngā Kaiwhakangahau, ngā Kaimanaaki o Ngā Kaiwhakangahau, Te Kaiwhakatairanga me Te Kaitiaki Kōiriiri e mōhio ai rātou ki ngā tikanga o te whare karioi.

Venue Manager

This is who you'll be dealing with to book the venue. They deal with the scheduling of the venue, and will deal with artist, artist manager, promoter or booking agent on expectations for use of their venue.

6 Te Kaiwhakatairanga

Ko Te Kaiwhakatairanga te kaiwhakahaere o ngā wahāna katoa o te kaupapa ahakoa te kaupapa. Ka whakarite tēnei tangata i ngā Kaiwhakangahau me ngā Pēne. Kei tēnei tangata te Kawenga ki te whakatairanga me te whakapāhoō whānui i te konohete. Nā, kei tēnei tangata te mana ki te kōwhiri i te waahi o te konohete anō hoki. Ka whai waahi atu Te Kaiwhakatairanga ki ngā tikiti, ka mutu, ka whai Te Kaiwhakatairanga i te taha pūtea e mōhio ia kua utua katoatia ngā nama.

Promoter

Promoters are the organisers behind gigs, and they're responsible for pretty much everything. They book the artists and bands, are responsible for marketing and promoting the concert, and are in charge of picking venues. They also deal with ticketing and making sure everyone who needs paying is paid.

8 Te Kaitiaki Kōiriiri

Ko te mahi i Te Kaitiaki Kōiriiri ko te manaaki i ngā Kaiwhakangahau ki ngā hui mataora. Koia te ringa tūhono i waengani i te tira ngahau me Te Kaiwhakatairanga o te hui. Ka whakawhitī kōrero, ka whakatau tēnei tangata, mehemea he waahi pai mō a rātou Kaiwhakangahau ki te kōkiri i tētahi kaupapa. Ko ngā momo kaupapa ki ēnei kōrero whakawhitīwhiti ko te whakatau kīrimana, te whakarite i ngā taunakitanga, te wahanga whakaniko, e pai ai, e kōunga ake ai ngā mahi ki te atarima, ā, i etahi wā ko te whakatau i ngā haumarutanga o te kaupapa, arā, ngā waahi noho, te kai me ēra momo kōriiringa.

Booking Agent

Booking agents are essentially artist managers for live events. They are the liaison between the artist team and the event promoter. They deem which environments are appropriate for their artist which can range from negotiating deals, arranging proper technical set-ups for shows and in many cases securing hospitality travel and other logistics.

9 Te Kaimanaaki Kaiwhakangahau

I te tētahi kawenga o Te Kaimanaaki Kaiwhakangahau ko te kimi angitu mō te Pēne me ngā Kaiwhakangahau, ā, i te orokohanga o te Pēne ka tiaki Te Kaimanaaki Kaiwhakangahau i ngā kōiriiri katoa o te Pēne.

Artist Manager

An artist manager is responsible for creating opportunities for the band or artist and in the beginning stages of a band's career is often times the booking agent as well.

10 Te Kaiwhakaahua

He tangata motuhake here-kore nei. Ka kuhu atu ki te kaupapa hei kaiwhakamātau mō te perehi ā-rohe, te whare karioi, Te Kaimanaaki Kaiwhakangahau rānei.

Photographer

Freelancers who may be contracted for local media, the venue, or artist manager.

11 Te Kairarotake / Te Kairangitaki

I te nuunga o te wā ka aro noa tēnei mātanga ki tētahi puoro motuhake. Nā, i te nuunga o te wā he rakuraku. Ko tētahi o ngā Kawenga o te tangata nei, ko te whakamātau kia tika ngā rangi o ngā rakuraku, mehemea e ora pā ana ngā taura me ngā taunakitanga anō hoki.

Reviewer/Bloggers

Will write a review of the show, usually by the next day.

12 Te Mātanga Pūtangitangi

I te nuunga o te wā ka aro noa tēnei mātanga ki tētahi puoro motuhake. Nā, i te nuunga o te wā he rakuraku. Ko tētahi o ngā Kawenga o te tangata nei, ko te whakamātau kia tika ngā rangi o ngā rakuraku, mehemea e ora pā ana ngā taura me ngā taunakitanga anō hoki.

Instrument Technician

Usually specialises in one instrument, often guitars. Will make sure all guitars are tuned, and ensure effects and cables are all working correctly.

13 Te Kaitiaki Takapau

Ko tētahi o ngā Kawenga o Te Kaitiaki Takapau ko te whakakūne i te mahere kia tika ngā mahi a ngā Kaiwhakangahau ki runga i te atamira, kia tua o te atamira anō hoki. Ko tētahi atu Kawenga ko te whakaringaringa i ngā kōriiringa o ngā Kaiwhakangahau huuha ki muri i te atamira.

Stage Manager

Ensures everything on stage goes to plan including performers on and off stage on time and organising logistics of multiple performers and backline on stage.
