The Blue Goose General Store has opened as an ongoing effort to provide opportunities for our community to have access to local grown produce, locally sourced food items and local artisan products. We invite the 'Community at Large' to regularly visit the Blue Goose General Store to shop, eat and to enjoy the slower pace of rural life. As an artist in our community, we invite you to join the Blue Goose as a vendor.

The Process

Make contact with the Blue Goose General Store via U.S. Mail, phone, or email to confirm your interest in placing your original artwork, food item or specialty retail item for sale in the Blue Goose General Store. You may also stop by the Blue Goose General Store to pick up a copy of the Consignment Agreement and Guidelines or access it online at our website at looseatthegoose.com.

A member of the Blue Goose team will contact you to discuss your interest and to exchange information regarding current space available in the shop and timing of delivery.

Consignment inventory shall include, but not be limited to:

Wall-hung art (paintings, drawings, photographs, serigraphs and prints of original artworks, folk art)

Wearable art (scarves, clothing, jewelry, hats, purses, etc.)

3-D Art – Decorative and Functional (art glass, pottery and ceramics, wood carvings, sculpture, etc.)

Consumable Items: Soaps, lotions, lip glosses. Items should be a natural based as possible and small batched. Greeting Cards (created from original art).

Selection of Shop Inventory: The Blue Goose owner shall have the final word on selection of inventory. Consideration will be given to salability, design, technique, seasonality and appropriateness of shop inventory.

The Blue Goose General Store reserves the right to reject works that do not meet our standards or will not fit within the confines of space available.

Following acceptance of your artwork for consignment sale in the Blue Goose General Store, you will be asked to complete The Consignment Agreement Form and provide an Inventory Sheet.

Consignment Agreement Form

Artisan shall price his/her works to encourage sales, enable purchases as gifts and offer items at a wide range of price points.

Pricing by artists is not to exceed \$300 per item. The consignment fee due to the Blue Goose shall be 30% of the sales price. 70% of the sales price will be remitted to the Artist. Artists will be paid for sold work in the gift shop within two weeks of the ending of the month. Operation of the Blue Goose General Store shall be handled by staff of the Blue Goose with occasional assistance from artists. Insurance is NOT provided for artist's work. We will do our best to place all work in secure displays. Damage to art work from customers or staff is NOT the responsibility of the Blue Goose General Store. Bags and packaging for purchase will be the provided by the Blue Goose General Store.
