Once they have opened you risk self pollination

Now cover the stamper with a straw and wait +- 1 day for it to become receptive to pollen



Stamper not 100% receptive to pollen note the green colour of the tips



Stamper now receptive to pollen, note the white colour of the tips

Using a self tie label mark the date of flowering, flower count etc. Also note the pollination to be done, we use black & white paint markers



Tie the label around the penducle of the flower



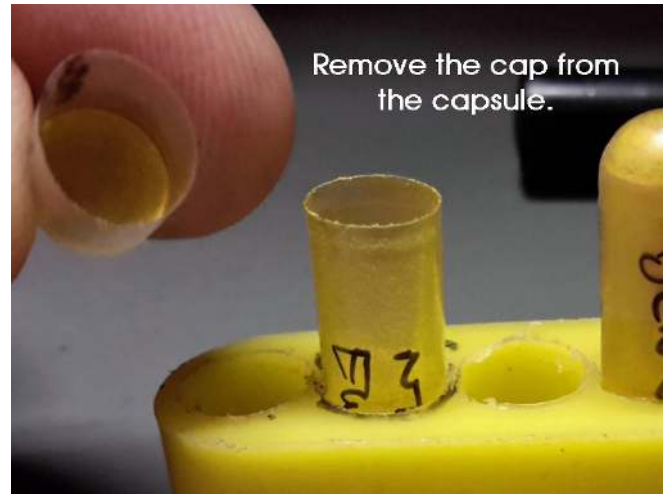


How we Pollinate our Clivia

Stored Pollen in gel capsules



Remove the cap from the capsule.



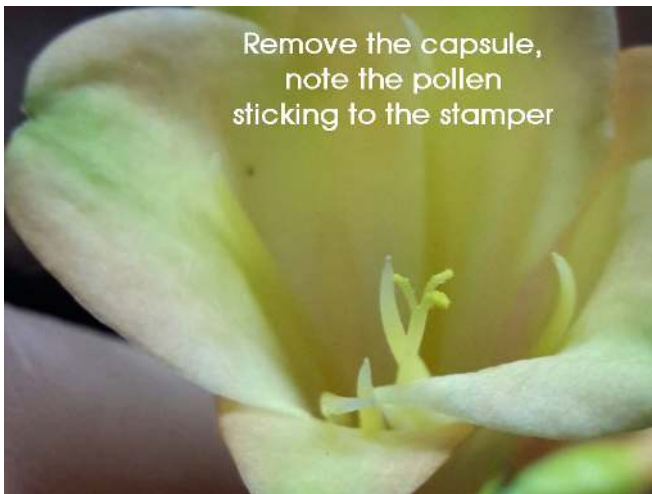
Slide over the stamper so it makes contact with the pollen



Twist and turn the capsule a few times, be gentle



Remove the capsule, note the pollen sticking to the stamper

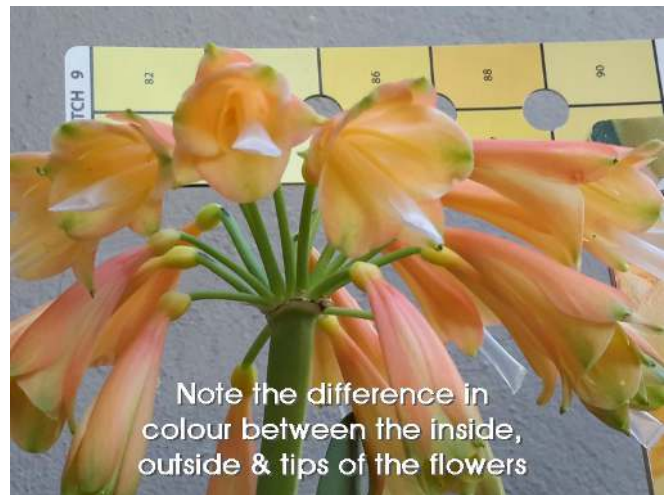
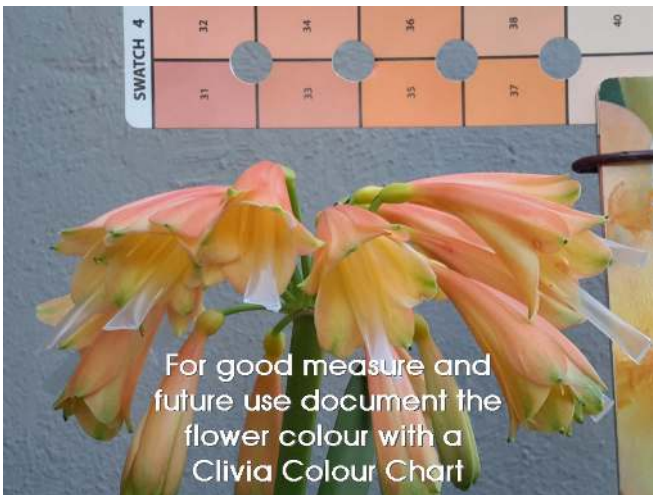


Mark the flowers that have been pollinated with the relevant code / colour

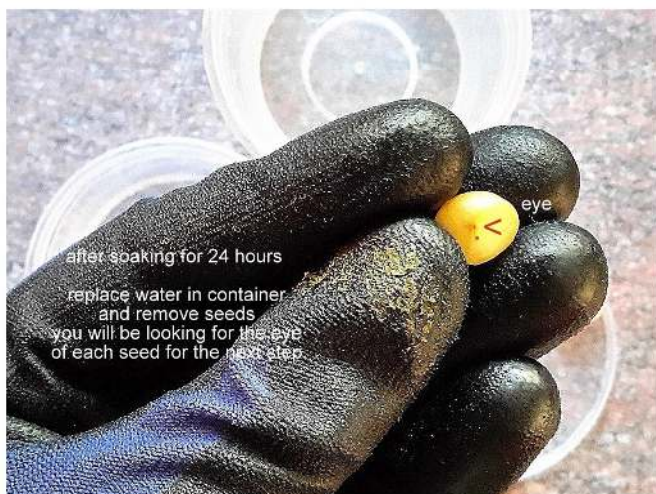

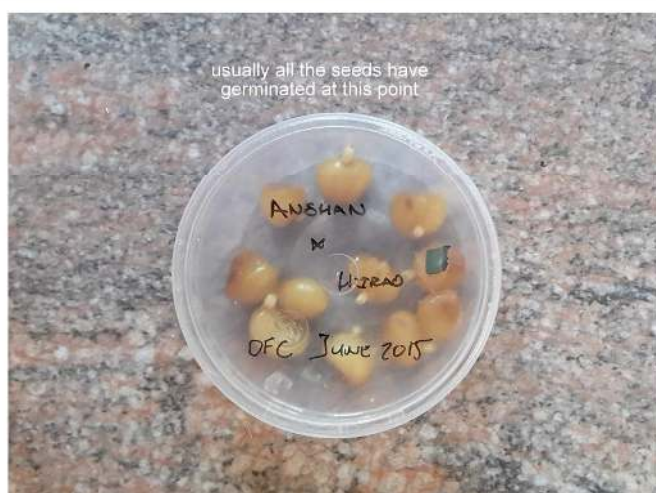
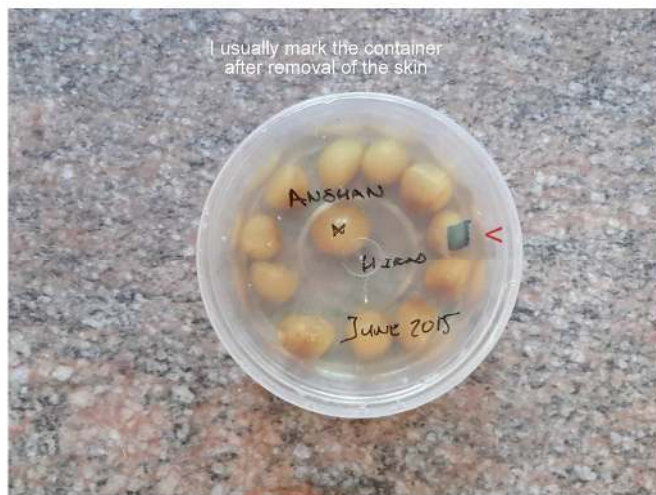
