



remove each individual seed from the secondary membrane that encase them



Try to remove all bits and pieces dont leave any membrane on the seeds




soak your seed in the solution for 24 hours

Sterilize all your equipment with the spirits before storage




also sterilize your glove to avoid cross contamination



strain off the bleach solution and replace with clean water
(do not rinse off seed)




soak in water for another 24 hours



after soaking for 24 hours

replace water in container and remove seeds you will be looking for the eye of each seed for the next step




find the eye of each seed & use the tweezers to remove the outer skin covering the eye of the seed this should be soft after soaking



exposing the eye of the seed greatly increases germination rate and percentage

exposed eye






after removing all the outer skins that cover the eyes submerge the seeds in clean water and soak for 24 hours
