Cabin Instructions & Rules

- Check-in: 3:00 pm / Check-out: 10:00 am
- No pets allowed
- Please park next to your cabin
- Quiet hours: 10:00 pm - 6:00 am
- Campfires are allowed in designated fire rings. You are responsible for monitoring & extinguishing your fire
- Please do not flush anything besides toilet paper down the toilets
- No Smoking or Vaping
- No ATVs or 4-Wheelers allowed
- No public restroom

Frequently Asked Questions:

- Is Hatcher Pass RV close to Denali National Park?
 - We are at the base of Hatcher's Pass on the Willow side. This means that we are a great stop on your way to or back from Denali National Park. The park is about 160 miles from our location.
- Is there a restaurant close by?
 - Yes! Beginning summer of 2024, Willow Creek Bakery will be open on site! We will proudly offer breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Stop by to fuel your adventures!
- What else is there to do in Willow?
 - If you like the outdoors, Willow is the place for you! There are numerous lakes and creeks with endless trail

systems and access to public land. We are at the base of Hatcher's Pass, which is an outdoor enthusiast's dream! Willow offers two gas stations, a couple of restaurants, and a hardware store.

- How far is the closest grocery store?
 - The closest grocery store is in Big Lake. If you are coming north from Anchorage, you will find it easiest to stop in Wasilla at one of the many stores there.
