

2025 Corvette ZR1 Overview


- Powertrain: A flat-plane crank (FPC) twin-turbocharged 5.5 liter LT7,
- Power: A whopping 1,064 HP with 828 lb-ft of torque! Record milestone numhers for the brand
- Performance: "Significantly faster than 212 mph" and "under a 16 second quarter mile"
- Pricing: Car and Driver reports a starting price in the range of \$180,000 to \$205,000,
- Availability: The 2025 model year is confirmed
- No electric motors are on the front wheels; speculation is the hybrid will be reserved for the ZORA.
- There is an 8000 RPM redline (down 600 from the C8 Z06's LT6 to accommodate the turbos)
- According to Tadge, there are numerous engineering upgrades for the LT7, including thicker forged titanium rods.
- The first turbo-charged Corvette ever!
- The iconic Split Window design is back!



Cool Features That Differentiate The ZR1

The beast behind the creation, the nearly all-new twin-turbocharged flat-plane crank 5.5 liter LT7

There is no storage frunk. This area is now used for aerodynamics and cooling, with the aggressive highly-engineered heat-extracting hood releasing air sucked in from the large front grill. Air will flow through two new additional "gigantic" radiators where the traditional C8 frunk used to be.



The large hatch nostrils are air inlets for the twin turbos and are only available on the ZTK-equipped ZR1 Coupe.

The iconic Split Window design is back! The wing for the ZTK option is HUGE!

Newport Car Museum

On Sunday June 30 members of EMCC along with members of the Bay State Corvette Club met at Aviva' Trattoria in Wrentham for a cruise to the Newport Car Museum in Portsmouth Rhode Island. The museum is a collection of some of the most beautiful and rarest cars found.

The owners of the museum, Gunther and Maggie Buerman have collected and assembled the cars in different rooms. There is a room dedicated to Porsche's most rare race and street cars includ-



ing actual race cars campaigned in endurance races such as the 24 hours of Lemans. There is another room called "Fins" feating cars from the 50's. As you enter that room you are greeted by a 1959 Cadillac Eldorado Biarritz convertible finished in Ermine white with this gred interior spinning on a turntable, its' signature tail fins and twin taillights sparkling. Nearby are a pair of Chevrolet's convertible One is a Robins egg blue 57 Belair, with a matching blue top and interior. Next to it is a 57 Impala finished in Coral with a matching Coral top and plaid interior. What is so special about these cars is that they both have every option available for the year including air conditioning.




Another room features European sports cars including a 55 Mercedes SL300 Gullwing coupe in showroom condition. Also, two of what I consider the most beautiful European cars, a Jaguar XKE Type 1, and a Lamborghini Miura also in new condition.

Of Course there are Corvettes. A whole room full of every model from C1, a 1954, up to a C8. Noteworthy Corvettes consist of the iconic 63 coupe with its signature split rear window, with fuel injection. There are two big block 435 HP cars, a 67 and a 69, a 90 ZR1, along with other noteworthy cars from each generation.

Other rooms are dedicated to Ford and Shelby cars including a race ready GT40. There are exhibits for Mopar, and American Muscle then and now, which has Muscle cars from the 60, 70, s and newer Muscle cars. The exhibits are all tastefully done with décor and posters from the era of the cars. It is truly a museum worth visiting.

Following the tour we all went to the Portsmouth Public house for lunch/dinner. I say dinner because service was very slow. We were all there for 2 1/2 hours, which in retrospect wasn't too bad. After we were seated the skies opened and rained for quite a while. The rail was nearly over when we finished eating. Part of the fun was joining the Bay State club and meeting new Corvette enthusiasts and sharing stories. It was a great afternoon.


