Dear Friend of Labor, History and Culture,

On February 20, 2026, the National A. Philip Randolph Pullman Porter Museum (NAPRPPM) will celebrate its 31st founding anniversary and will host the 2026 A. Philip Randolph "Gentle Warrior Awards" Gala. This is our annual primary fundraiser, which will be held at Wintrust Grand Banking Hall 231 S. LaSalle, Chicago, Illinois, from 6:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.

We excitedly invite you to join us for this fantastic celebration as the labor community recognizes some of their very own. The honorees include James Connolly, Chicago Laborers District Council, Juan Campos, Secretary Treasurer International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 705, Keith Richardson, General President American Postal Workers Local 1, and Ephrin Jenkins, Founder and President of The Black Labor Week Project, Inc.

These aforementioned recipients have not only invoked change but manifested impact throughout their community involvement, political savvy, passion for advocacy and other areas of influence—leading by example.

A Philip Randolph organized the Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters, the first Black labor union in America chartered under the American Federation of Labor (AFL). Randolph was one of America's foremost labor and civil rights leaders, who became known as the "Gentle Warrior." The Award is presented in three categories: The Gentle Warrior, The Change Agent and the Descendant of Distinction. Recipients are individuals who exhibit the similar commitment, focus, and tenacity that Randolph displayed throughout his career.

Additional award recipients include individuals from the broader community, business and political sectors. Among the honorees are Larita Clark, CEO of Metropolitan Pier Exposition Authority (MPEA), Kimberly Du Buckle, Illinois State Representative, 5th District, Dr. Kisha McCaskill, Commissioner Cook County 5th District, Tracy Murray, Descendant of Distinction Great-grand Niece of Pullman Porters, Chief -of-Staff, 9th-Ward-Ald. Anthony Beale, and another first, an honoree couple—Spencer Senior and Henrietta Leak, of Leak and Sons Funeral Home Enterprises.

The NAPRPP Museum a 501(c)3, a cultural institution located in the Pullman National Historical Park District, designated by President Barack Obama in 2015. Founded in 1995, the NAPRPPM is the only museum of its kind worldwide. The museum is a public, independently operated Black labor history museum—that promotes critical lessons that cross age, class, color, and gender boundaries, carrying messages critical to our society.

A successful "Gentle Warrior Awards" event plays a significant role in funding our operational budget and enables us to continue our vital work! 


