We also pray for the Catechumens, those who are preparing to become Orthodox through baptism or chrismation for Easter and we sense a direct connection of the Early Church, and understand the initial character of Lent as preparation for Baptism and for Easter. The next Salutation Service will be Friday, April 1 beginning at 7 p.m. On Friday, April 8, we will chant all the stanzas of the Salutations called the "Akathist Hymn." Please join us for all these most beautiful and meaningful services dedicated to the Virgin Mary as we commemorate the Feast of the Annunciation through these services.

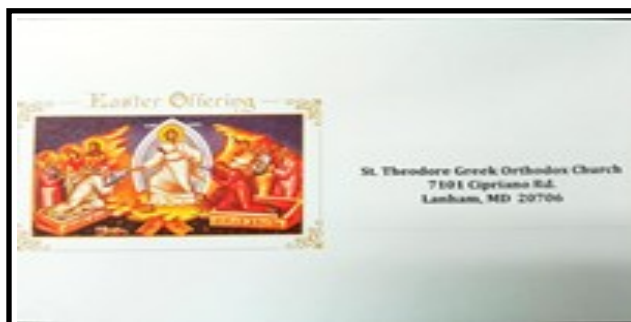
