

St. Theodore Church invites you to welcome our Lord into Jerusalem by coming to church, receiving your blessed palms and then to participate in the festive Fish Luncheon prepared by our Ladies Philoptochos Society. Let us then follow the Bridegroom Christ on his way to His Crucifixion on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evenings at 6 p.m. Let us be anointed with the Holy Prayer Oil of Unction on Wednesday evening at 6 p.m. On Thursday evening, we are called to ascend with the Lord to Golgotha bearing with

Him the heavy cross during the procession and the 12 gospel readings. On Good Friday let us witness the taking down of our Lord's precious Body from the Cross at 3 p.m. and then let us gather back at 6 p.m. as we accompany our Lord on his journey into the depths of the earth and preaching to those who were bound there. Let us offer to carry His Body around theoutside of the Church as a moving indication that we are following our Lord into His kingdom and yearning to be saved by going under the sepulcher and re-entering into the Church which is our salvation.




