A CHRISTMAS MESSAGE by Fr. Manuel J. Burdusi

On Christmas afternoon and the days after, adults and children ask one another "What did you get for Christmas?" This is one way you can open a conversation with another person. The trouble with this emphasis on what we get at Christmas is that the whole point of this holy season is in giving not getting. We give gifts at Christmas in humble imitation of the Gift that God gave all of us – His Only Son, our Lord

Jesus Christ. God gave to us the very best He had, His Son. For all of us, the emphasis is on giving, not on getting. Let us help make real to one another the true spirit of Christmas which is the love of Christ. Material gifts are wonderful, but there are many gifts that are not material. The most personal and appreciated gift that you can give is the gift of time. Your time, those valuable 24 hours per day can only be spent by you, no one else. How do we choose to spend our time?

In addition to the gift of time, we can give the gift of friendship. Instead of asking "how many friends do I have?" we need to ask, "how many people can I be a friend to?" Find people who need you and let them know you care.

The greatest gifts are free – the gift of encouragement, the gift of appreciation, the gift of forgiveness, the gift of understanding, the gift of listening and being truly present with someone. To be sensitive to what others are really saying, to give one's whole and serious attention to another person, to adults but especially to children, is a real gift.

Through Jesus we receive the gift of being members of God's family. The house in which we come together as God's family in the house of God, which is our Church. I ask you during this time of giving to remember your Church, the Church of St. Theodore on your Christmas list of gift-giving. Remember what the church has given you and what it continues to offer to you. Remember to submit your stewardship pledge form and your initial payment to the church during this most blessed season of giving.

So when we are asked, "What did you get for Christmas?" Our answer should be, "I got Christ as my Savior and Lord"! And because I have received him, I can only respond by giving my time, my love and my care to those around me. Merry Christmas everyone!


