HOLY COMMUNION AND THE PANDEMIC

It was so great to see everyone on Father's Day, Sunday June 21, 2020 as we reopened for the first time since mid-March. We have missed everyone for so long and now we are able to worship again together as one family of God. If you think about more deeply and theologically, we were never separated for what can separate us from the love of God and when we are in prayer together, we are united as one. I want to discuss about Holy Communion because I know that there has been a lot of discussion about the pandemic and how it is going to affect our receiving of Holy Communion. The decision of the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople, the Church of Greece, the Church of Cyprus, and all the Metropolises of the United States except for New York, have decided that Holy Communion is to continue to be given as it has always been and that there is no need to deviate from the current practice.

When we partake of Holy Communion, we partake not of something that is subject to decay and deterioration, but of God Himself, through matter that has become life giving, as the very flesh of Christ is life giving. St. Cyril of Alexandria writes, "The body of Christ is holy and has the power to vanquish every illness. It was and is holy, not merely as flesh with its natural powers, but as the temple of the indwelling divine word of God who sanctifies his flesh with His Spirit." Therefore, to those that receive Holy Communion with faith and true repentance the Lord's Body becomes a safeguard for strength, healing, and health of soul and body, for the maintenance and deification of human nature.

Our professor of Liturgy, Fr. Alkiviades Calivas, who has been a priest for 65 years, writes the following: "In my 65 years of being a priest, I have consumed the chalice thousands of times after countless Divine Liturgies without fear or hesitation, as every priest does. Holy Communion is a source of joy, hope and strength for everyone and not a test or measure of one's faith in God's care. The only danger is to receive Holy Communion in an unworthy manner as St. Paul has taught but none of the Saints ever taught in the last 2000 years or even suggested that the Eucharist could be a means of transmitting a disease. None did. In fact the opposite has been taught. Priests have communed people with diseases such as herpes, cholera, HIV, other sexually transmitted diseases, tuberculosis and rabies and other such communicable diseases and no one has ever gotten sick through the chalice or the spoon of Holy Communion.

I did some research and in an article from **<u>Bio-Orthodoxy</u>**, there have actually been scientific studies on the transmission of infectious diseases through Holy Communion and the conclusion is that there is an undetectable measure of risk or no risk at all. These studies were done in 1943, 1967, 1988, 1995, 1996, and 1997. Therefore, we can receive without fear of contamination, but with the fear of God, with faith and with love to come forth and receive. If however, you would like to refrain, you may do so without any judgement. Wait and see for yourself. Let time be your witness and see that no one will get sick from communion. Let time show you that it is safe, if you want. Many Orthodox churches have opened much earlier than we did, and there have been no reports of anyone getting sick from Holy Communion.

Your risk is more so if you do not wear a mask in closed public places and visit places where large quantities of people are assembled and you don't know where they have been. Science has taught us that this is an airborne disease and a respiratory disease foremost. So please follow the guidelines that have been established i.e. the washing of hands, sanitizer, not touching your face or nose, social distancing of six feet apart and wearing a mask. You have two options when you come forth and take off your mask for communion. You can receive as you always have, or you can open your mouth wide and tilt your head back and I can place the communion in your mouth without you touching the spoon if you would like. Again, no one will judge you for your decision on what you choose to do. Let us all allow our faith to guide us to do what we feel is comfortable and you can always change your decision at any time. May God be with us always and I hope that this article has helped in calming whatever fears that you may have had and may you come forward prepared to receive Holy Communion.

AUGUST 1-14 PANAGIA'S LENT

The Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary is celebrated on August 15. The Feast commemorates the repose or "falling-asleep" of the Mother of Jesus Christ, our Lord. The Feast also commemorates the translation or assumption into heaven of the body of the Theotokos. The Comemoration of the Dormition of the Theotokos and the preparation for the Feast begin on August 1 with a period of fasting. A strict fast is followed on most of the days (no meat, dairy, oil, or wine), with the exceptions of fish on the Feast of the Transfiguration (August 6). Oil and Wine are allowed on Saturdays and Sundays. On the weekdays before the Feast, Paraklesis services are held which are services of supplication and prayer for the health of the living. Please see special form below to complete for prayers for health. Paraklesis Services will be held at 6 p.m. on the following days: Monday, August 3rd; Friday, August 7th; Monday, August 10th; and Wednesday, August 12th.

On Wednesday, August 5, we will be celebrating Great Vespers at 6 p.m. for the feast of Holy Transfiguration and on Thursday, August 6, 2020, Orthros will begin at 9 am and the Divine Liturgy at 10 am.

On Friday, August 14, we will be celebrating Great Vespers at 6 p.m. for the feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos and on Saturday, August 15, 2020, Orthros will begin at 9 am and the Divine Liturgy at 10 am.
