#### YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Those of us who observe the Sermon on the Mount are called the "light of the world". We need to shine forth before all so that others may see our good works and give glory to our Father who is in heaven.

Christ Himself is the true light and He is the source of light and life. We as His believers

are lights of the world only in so much as we absorb and reflect the light from the Divine Light who is Jesus Christ. He is our source of guidance, direction and blessing. He is the one who leads us to salvation. In as much as we yield ourselves to Him then we too can be instruments of His salvation to point others along the path which leads to salvation.

We can confidently shine forth as we do good works and live according to the commandments of Christ because it is God who is shining through us. We can reflect His Divine Light and this is possible because of the Holy Spirit. We are vessels of the Holy Spirit and it is He who uses us to glorify God and point others by word and deed to a new life. Just as the apostles gathered around the Lord and learned from Him, so too we need to gather close to the Lord who is our Good Shepherd. As long as we abide at the Lord's feet, we never need to fear about walking in darkness. God is gracious, full of compassion, full of tender mercy and loving kindness and He is always ready to forgive.

We see that our Lord has crystallized the essence of the teachings of the Old Testament which is love for God and love for neighbor. It is the complete meaning of discipleship as well as the identifying feature of the Church.

If we love God and neighbor then all other things will fall into place – sin will have no more place in the life of the believer and the Cross and Resurrection are the believer's adoration. God is love and the good works we are to do for others are works of love and compassion. And it is for this that witnesses will glorify our Father who is in heaven. God's love for us is limitless. He gave His Son to us that we might believe in Him and be saved. Christ went to the cross so that we might receive eternal life. It is up to us to communicate God's love to a suffering and confused world by pointing people and introducing them to the Good Shepherd who is Christ our Lord. Christ will draw all to Himself, all we need to do is to be faithful disciples, faithful to the Gospel and to let our light shine before others that the world can see the blessed hope and know deep within their hearts that God is love.

Please join us, now that the pandemic is ending and it is safe to come back to church. Join us for Liturgy each and every Sunday beginning at 10:15 a.m. Let us not let complacency preside, but allow us to recommit to coming to church on a regular basis and allow the grace of the Holy Spirit to mature to fullness of the stature of Christ. Amen.

#### **AUGUST I—I4 PANAGIA'S LENT**

The Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary is celebrated on August 15. The Feast commemorates the repose or "falling-asleep" of the Mother of Jesus Christ, our Lord. The Feast also commemorates the translation or assumption into heaven of the body of the Theotokos. The Comemoration of the Dormition of the Theotokos and the preparation for the Feast begins on August I with a period of fasting. A strict fast is followed on most of the days (no meat, dairy, oil, or wine), with the exceptions of fish on the Feast of the Transfiguration (August 6). Oil and Wine are allowed on Saturdays and Sundays. On the weekdays before the Feast, Paraklesis services are held which are services of supplication and prayer for the health of the living. Please see special form below to complete for prayers for health. Paraklesis Services will be held at 6 p.m. on the following days: Monday, August 2nd, Wednesday, August 4, Monday, August 9th; Wednesday, August 11th; and Friday, August 13th.

On Thursday, August 5, we will be celebrating Great Vespers at 6 p.m. for the feast of Holy Transfiguration and on Friday, August 6, 2021, Orthros will begin at 9 am and the Divine Liturgy at 10 am.

On Saturday, August 14, we will be celebrating Great Vespers at 6 p.m. for the feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos and on Sunday, August 15, 2021, Orthros will begin at 9 am and the Divine Liturgy at 10 am.
