

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Pentecost is Sunday, June 4. Orthros at 8:30 am, Divine Liturgy at 10:00 am. followed by the Great Vespers of Pentecost and the kneeling prayers. On this day, the seventh Sunday of Pascha, the tenth day after the Ascension and the fiftieth day after Pascha, at the third hour of the day from the rising of the sun, there suddenly came a sound from Heaven, as when a mighty wind blows, and it filled the whole house where the Apostles and the rest with them were gathered. Immediately after the sound, there appeared tongues of fire that divided and rested upon the head of each one. Filled with the Spirit, all those present began speaking not in their native tongue, but in other tongues and dialects, as the Holy Spirit instructed them. This gave them the power and the strength to go out and preach the word of God to the world. Let us come and attend this special service to receive the blessings of the church and so that the power of the Holy Spirit may continue to work within us and for our Church.

50TH ANNIVERSARY FUNDRAISING PROJECT

Father Manuel introduced to us an easy fund-raising effort that everyone can participate in to help with the many expenses for the Anniversary celebration. Just as a wedding is a very costly but worthy endeavor and memorable event for the couple, a Church anniversary also incurs expenses that are not part of the normal yearly budget. We are grateful to be a part of the 50th Anniversary of the Church and help in whatever way we can. There will be 100 envelopes between \$1.00 and \$100.00 dollars for you to make your donation to the Church. If all the envelopes are submitted, \$5000 will be raised. We will do this now at the beginning and again in the Fall, September – November. There will be many expenses to have the Archbishop of America come in December and his entourage. They will need to be placed in a hotel and we are to have their tickets to the banquet complimentary as well as the tickets of all the past priests who have served the church and the area priests. This along with other special expenses add up. We pray that you have an unforgettable experience this year for our 50th Anniversary. PHILOPTOCHOS SCHOLARSHIP

With the blessings of His Grace Bishop Apostolos of Medeia, and those of the Very Reverend Father Christoforos Oikonomidis, our Metropolis Chancellor, the Metropolis of New Jersey Philoptochos is once again offering an opportunity to qualifying High School seniors, who are enrolled in an accredited University, College or Trade School, to apply for a Metropolis of New Jersey Philoptochos merit based scholarship. An annual award of \$1000.00 to help Greek Orthodox women pursue studies that will lead to, enhance, or extend careers in business. Eligible Applicants must be:

- Female • Baptized in the Greek Orthodox Church* • Accepted by, or enrolled in, an accredited educational institution/program of study; and • In, or about to initiate, a course of study directly related to a career in business. *

Note that preference will be given to congregants of Saint Sophia Greek Orthodox Cathedral. Send your completed application as a PDF attachment in an email with the subject line reading “Apostolos Scholarship Application” to PhiloptochosDC@gmail.com no later than midnight on the Fourth of July. Application Requirements:

- A signed and completed copy of the application form; • Proof of baptism or chrismation as a Greek Orthodox Christian; • Proof of acceptance to, or enrollment in, an accredited educational institution or program directly related to a career in business; • Personal statement of intent; and • At least one letter of recommendation.

You can also set up with your checking account for a check to be mailed automatically from your bank to the Church, if desired. Smaller, regular payments are easier to manage than paying one lump sum at the beginning or end of the year. Actually, your giving power to the Church is strengthened if you can offer on a regular basis. Monthly is the preferred frequency.

Dear Parishioners,


