CHRISTOS ANESTI CHRIST IS RISEN TRULY HE IS RISEN

Abundant Life Through the Resurrection



Each of us in our daily life frequently senses the difference between existing and living. We want to live but often we merely exist as we deal with self, others, our job, marriage, family, problems and responsibilities. Christ said, "I came that you may have life, and have it abundantly" John 10:10 Christ's words were not merely intended for the future Kingdom, but also for our daily lives now. Christ completed his redemptive work through His person, teachings, death and resurrection.

Those who believe in Him can now enjoy the fruits of new life.

Both the Bible and Tradition assure us that a new life in Christ is possible for us now and it is a sure gift coming from the saving work of Christ. The saints were empowered by this new life and testify to it as a dynamic reality which changed their lives. This abundant new life can become a part of our daily existence when we cooperate with God and respond with our whole being to God. Our personal response to God is crucial. We must personally reaffirm our baptismal pledge and say "YES" to God, "I belong to You Oh Lord." Spiritual renewal comes from our commitment to Christ, receiving Holy Communion, through our daily prayers, and our sincere effort to live the kind of life that Christ lived and preached.

All this requires faith, repentance, and obedience. If we stumble and fall, God lovingly forgives us and teaches us precious lessons through our shortcomings. What matters the most is that we turn to Christ each time we fall and trust Him for strength and guidance and learn daily dependence on Him. Growth in Christ comes through our participation in the life of the Church. In our spiritual renewal, Christ is the center of the Church and the believer. As we pray in the Liturgy, we are to give ourselves and each other and our whole life to Christ our God. We must trust Christ and let Him rule so that all we think, say and do is according to His love, not according to our self will.

When we ask Him to come into our hearts, a personal relationship develops between Christ and the believer, as real as that between two good friends, or a husband and a wife. Spiritual renewal is a deeper knowledge of Christ Himself. Christ comes alive in us. As a church Father wrote: "For the believer Christ is everything."


