October 2020 – A Time to Reimagine the Parish with the Pandemic

We have been going through challenging times and these times are requiring us to make some changes in the way we do things. We are called to adapt to new situations and our parish is not an exception. We have come up with new ways of operating and for now we cannot go back to the way things were. The first thing that has changed and will remain for a while is the live streaming of our services which continues to fill a need to those who are not able to get out and come to church. Live streaming not only reaches our shut-ins, but also many people looking for a service to attend. Sharing our live stream over social media has helped expand our reach. And with the ability to record the service, it allows people to view at a later date and time as well. There

are many instances that hundreds of people viewed our services, especially during Holy Week this past year. This has been and continues to be a way of keeping people connected to their church in some way. However it does not take the place of actually being there and participating as if someone was present in the church. We must realize that and not become complacent with just watching church on Sunday on our laptops.

The second issue is that person to person ministry has been altered. The hands on approach has been largely shut down because of the requirements of physical distancing. Hopefully these will resume when conditions become better. Small group ministries for youth, Sunday School, Greek School, bible study, Philoptochos, and Parish councils have changed. Video conferencing has replaced in person meetings for now and some may continue as a preferred way to function. Our challenge is to keep these gatherings engaging for the participants. Join us for bible study on Wednesdays from 7:30 – 8:30 p.m. at the google meet site. The link to join the Bible Study is <u>meet.google.com/adh-cguj-cng</u>. Church school and Greek School are also on line and you can join if you like.

Communication is also vital for the parish to be able to continue its mission and purpose. We currently do not print our Sunday bulletin but it is delivered to everyone via email on Friday afternoon. Please take the time to read it to see if there are any new topics that have been written for your information. If you have an email address and are not receiving anything from us via email, that means we do not have your email in our database. Please send an email to <u>father@sttheodores.org</u> so that we can add you to our database. Ultimately our goal is to keep in touch with everyone. During the shutdown of the pandemic, many calls were made by Father to see if everyone is doing well.

Online giving has become vital for the survival of the parish with donations made in memory, for the health of, stewardship and regular donations. Please check the store at our website <u>www.sttheodores.org</u>. Online candle donations and prayers continue to provide an opportunity to those who cannot come to light a candle and send a prayer into the holy altar. It is our intention to have set up soon a credit card station in the narthex for candle donations and for stewardship payments and this will become a standard practice.

Parish life has changed greatly in light of the pandemic. The pandemic has cost many lives, thankfully we have not had anyone who has gotten sick in the parish and our hope is that no one ever gets sick. Inevitably the pandemic has caused a lot of stress and anxiety in many people's lives. Our experience of the pandemic has influenced much discussion and will probably continue to do so for several years to come. I pray everyone has a blessed and happy October month. Continue to stay safe and please try and come to church if you are able. We have many precautions in place to assure you that your visit to the church is safe and rewarding.

Join us every Wednesday from 7:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Each week, we will be studying a different book of the New Testament to allow us to become more familiar with each book.
