## Looking forward to the Ecclesiastical New Year

I pray that everyone is healthy and ready to begin a new ecclesiastical year. We have gone through much turmoil in 2020 because of the pandemic and it is so important for our faith and commitment to our Lord not waiver but grow and become stronger and more resilient. As Orthodox Christians, we are not called to live an easy life, but to live out our lives knowing that the road to salvation will have its challenges and we need to meet those challenges with faith and endurance and become stronger, not weaker.
