

Forfeit, no show, Lock out, alcohol and smoking Policy

Sept. 29, 2022

Effective immediately

Alcohol Policy

- 1. The Valley Premier Hockey League has a ZERO tolerance policy on Alcohol consumption in unlicensed areas of the Rinks at Summit Centre. This includes: lobbies, arena playing surfaces, benches, stands, and any area other than the dressing room. Any player/team found consuming alcoholic beverages in non-designated areas will result in a \$500 refundable bond that will have to be paid BEFORE their next game. The \$500 bond will be returned in full at the conclusion of the season if no further incidents arise. If a 2nd offence occurs, the \$500 bond will not be returned and the team/player will be suspended indefinitely from VPHL participation and must apply for reinstatement at a later date. No refunds will be issued for league fees under any circumstances.
- 2. The Rinks at Summit Centre has a strict no smoking policy in place. This must be adhered to by all Valley Premier Hockey Players.
- 3. Any Valley Premier Hockey player found to be playing under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be given a game ejection. Multiple offences could result in further action from the league convenor."



Lock Out Policy

- 1. The Valley Premier Hockey League has a no pay, no play policy in place. Teams must be paid up on or before the payment deadline, as set out at the start of the season.
- 2. If a team has not paid their dues on time, they will have until 24 hours prior to their next game to pay.
- 3. In the interest of the opposing team should the team not make the 24 hour deadline, the league convenor will look to find a replacement team for the game. The team locked out will NOT get the game back and it will be a forfeit.
- 4. Teams who can't play due to payment lock out, may be fined \$250 (reimbursed to the opposing team) if a game is cancelled or forfeited because of it.
- 5. The Valley Premier Hockey League reserves the right to disqualify any team, for the remainder of the season, that is continually delinquent on payments.

No Show Policy

- 1. Teams that no show to a game and give the league convener no warning will be fined the amount of \$250, payable to the league, which will be refunded to the opposing team for a game lost.
- 2. The fine is due prior to the following game.
- 3. Referees and timekeepers will be paid by the league in full for no show games.
- 4. No show games will NOT be rescheduled.

Forfeit Policy

1. If a team is unable to sport a line up, they are encouraged to call the League Convenor ASAP and he can either help facilitate more players to come out or can try to find a replacement team.



- 2. If the league convenor is NOT able to find a replacement team or spares, the forfeiting team will pay a fine of \$250, payable to the league, which will be refunded to the opposing team for a game lost.
- 3. The fine is due prior to the following game.
- 4. Referees and timekeepers will be paid by the league in full for forfeit games.
- 5. Forfeit games will NOT be rescheduled.
