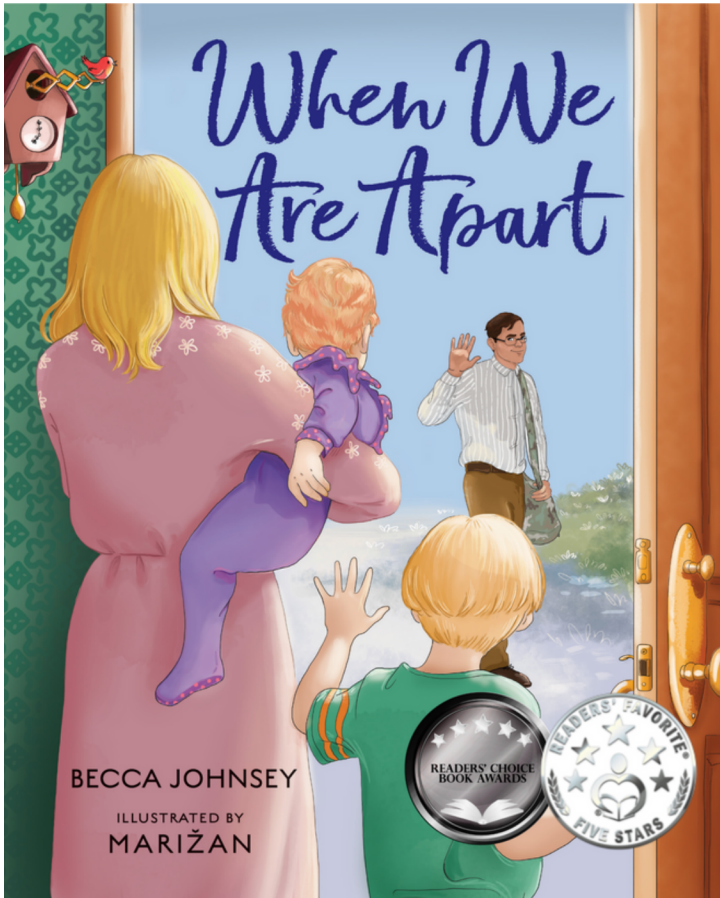

HELPFUL SUGGESTIONS



I wrote this book to help my children navigate their separation anxiety allowing them to name their feelings, deal with their emotions, and navigate through them while reminding them they are loved unconditionally.

I hope to come and meet your class, read *When We Are Apart*, and then answer any questions they may have. I will have worksheets that they can color if you so choose (written numbers if working on letters, numbers if working on counting, dinosaurs, cars, princesses, or animals).

The children can use their coloring sheets, cutting along the dotted lines to create a paper chain countdown, a visual representation of time passing.
