STAKE MISSION STATEMENT

Stake leaders will lovingly build and nurture relationships with stake members, ward priesthood and auxiliary leaders, through training, support and intentional personal actions in gathering Israel on both sides of the veil.

FOUNDATION

”No unhallowed hand can stop the work from progressing; persecutions may rage, mobs may combine, armies may assemble, calumny may defame, but the truth of God will go forth boldly, nobly, and independent, till it has penetrated every continent, visited every clime, swept every country, and sounded in every ear, till the purposes of God shall be accomplished, and the great Jehovah shall say the work is done” (History of the Church, 4:540).

This includes participating in missionary work and serving as missionaries and helping new and returning members progress along the covenant path. We are all children of Heavenly Father, who loves His children perfectly. He offers everyone the opportunity to be filled with His love through Jesus Christ and His gospel. One way we show our love for God is by loving and serving His children. We strive to love and serve as Jesus did. This love inspires us to reach out to people of all religions, races, and cultures. PLAN

Stake leaders will actively participate in the gathering of Israel on both sides of the veil in preparation for the second coming of the Savior Jesus Christ as we experience 19 convert baptisms in 2026 by:

1. Members of the Stake Council will personally prepare and participate in the gathering of Israel through daily prayer, study, and monthly fasting.
2. The Stake Council will study, review, and counsel together General Handbook section 23 at the third stake council of each quarter.
3. Members of the stake council will share an example of applying the principles found in Preach My Gospel each time they conduct or actively participate in a meeting with ward and stake leaders.
4. The stake clerk will assist the ward clerk in printing a list of part-member families and unbaptized children of record by the first Sunday of each quarter.
5. The ward clerk will provide a copy of the list to the assigned high counselor and the ward council on the first Sunday of each quarter.
6. The assigned High Counselor will encourage the ward ministering council to assign engaged ministers that will love and support those identified on the provided list with full fellowship and help them enter and remain on the covenant path.
7. Each assigned high counselor will obtain a list of ministering assignments from their assigned ward that corresponds to the names on the list of part-member families and unbaptized children of record by the fourth Sunday of each quarter.
8. The stake mission leader will teach the principles of Love, Share and Invite, and the Covenant Path Progress record in the second stake leadership training session each year.
9. Each assigned High Counselor will actively participate in the weekly ward mission correlation meeting to assist in creating an effective tool promoting missionary work in the ward.
10. An assigned member of the stake relief society, young women’s, young men’s, and primary presidencies will attend each ward’s weekly missionary correlation meeting a minimum of once each quarter.
11. Each assigned High Counselor, and a member of the Stake Relief Society Presidency will review the ward Covenant Path Progress record, Ward Mission Plan, and annual goal progress with the Elder’s Quorum and Relief Society presidency on a quarterly basis.
12. The members of the high council and relief society presidency will provide a brief written report on their assigned ward’s part-member families, unbaptized children of record lists, ministering assignments to these families, and the status of the weekly ward ministering council to be included in the third quarter stake council agenda.
