

J. K. Rowling Trivia

- Applied to Oxford University. Rejected.
- Was researcher for Amnesty Intl. when she got the idea for Harry Potter while on a delayed train to London in 1990.
- Based the character of Hermione Granger on herself when she was 11.
- 1993 separated from her first husband, no job, baby daughter. Went on welfare.
- 1997 Philosopher's Stone published.
- Initial print run 500 copies. Collectors have paid > \$80,000 for one recently.
































Trivia about Hogwarts:


