What: Free museum displaying hundreds of artifacts tied to 250 years of America's wars. Collection includes more than 10,000 military artifacts from the Revolutionary War, War of 1812, the Civil War, World War I, World War II, and the Korean, Vietnam, and Gulf wars.

- WWII pigeon carrier bicycle modified by Harley Davidson.
- Bible that stopped a bullet from killing an Army Chaplain.
- WWI horse gas masks.
