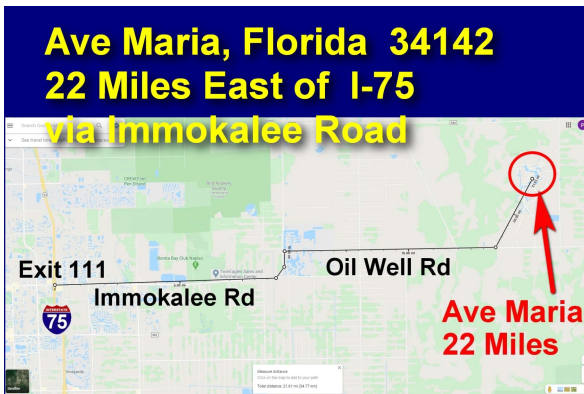


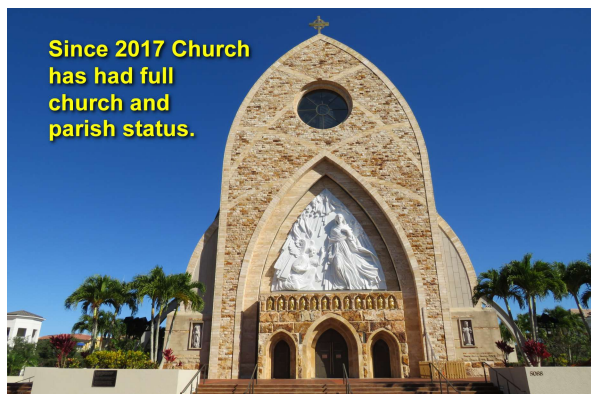
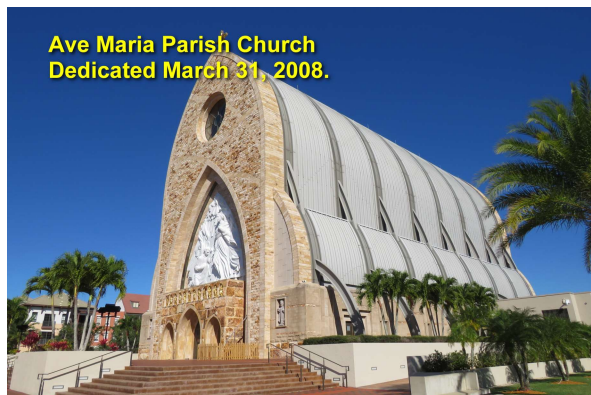


Ave Maria, Florida
Planned Catholic College Town
Website: <https://www.avemaria.com/>
Where: Ave Maria, FL 34142. About 26 miles east of Naples.
Get There: East on Immokalee Rd. Right on Oil Well Road. About 1 hour drive.
When: Daily. (Do not visit the Parish Church during mass.)
Admission: Free.



What: Ave Maria is a planned Catholic college town near Immokalee, Florida.
 – About 25 miles east of Naples.
 – Established 2005 by a partnership of Barron Collier Companies and the Ave Maria Foundation.
 – The foundation was led by Tom Monaghan, who reportedly invested \$250 million in the town and its university.
 – Monaghan is founder of Domino's Pizza.
 – Estimated population: Hard to pin down.

What To Do:
Visit Ave Maria Parish Church: 2008. 1,100 seats. Unique architecture (esp. interior steelwork). Open daily. Guided tours Tues and Thurs 1pm, 1:30pm, 2pm.
Visit Ave Maria University: Private, Catholic university. 1,200 students.
Visit Mother Teresa Museum on University campus: Daily except Mondays 12-5pm. Life and legacy of St Teresa of Calcutta.
Still some orange groves near Ave Maria.

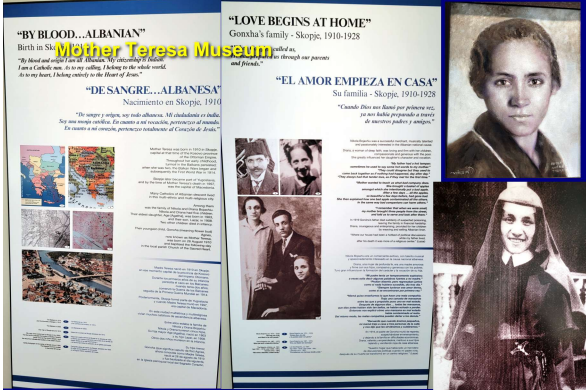

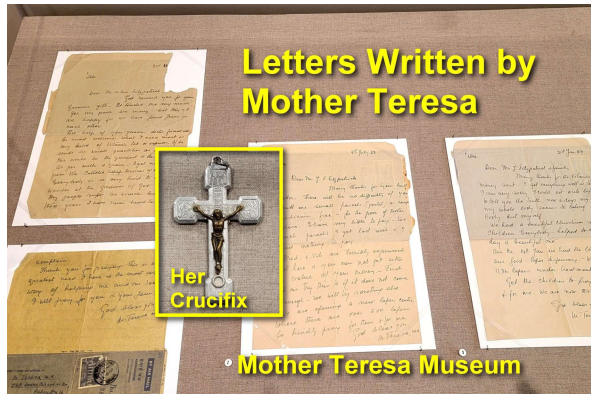

Mother Teresa was proclaimed "Saint" by Pope Francis on 4 September 2016 in St. Peter's Square, in front of about 120,000 pilgrims from around the world at a Mass celebrated for the workers and volunteers of mercy during the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy.
